

Microsoft reminds users: Windows 10 v1909 is about to die, take note!

If your Windows 10 computer is still running on version 1909, version 1903 or earlier, chances are you have seen a new message appear in your system tray that says: Your version of Windows 10 will reach the end of service soon.

This is a message telling you that the version of Windows 10 you're using is about to end. Support for Windows 10 version 1909 will officially end on May 11, 2021. At that time, you will no longer receive any software updates or essential support.

Specifically, according to the official announcement from Microsoft, the support package for Windows 10 version 1909 will officially end on May 11, 2021. From now until that time, the Redmond company wants to convince people. Users upgrade to the latest Windows 10 May 2020 Update or October 2020 Update, which comes with more comprehensive support, as well as a more optimized user experience.

1909 is the second major feature update of Windows 10 in 2019, focusing on improving the features already in the 1903 update as well as improving the overall performance of the system, and highly appreciated by users since launch.

To recommend that users upgrade to a newer version of Windows 10, Microsoft has now started displaying a reminder message about the end of service support. This message will appear automatically in the system tray. Of course users can still turn off notifications, but it will always show up again until they upgrade the system.

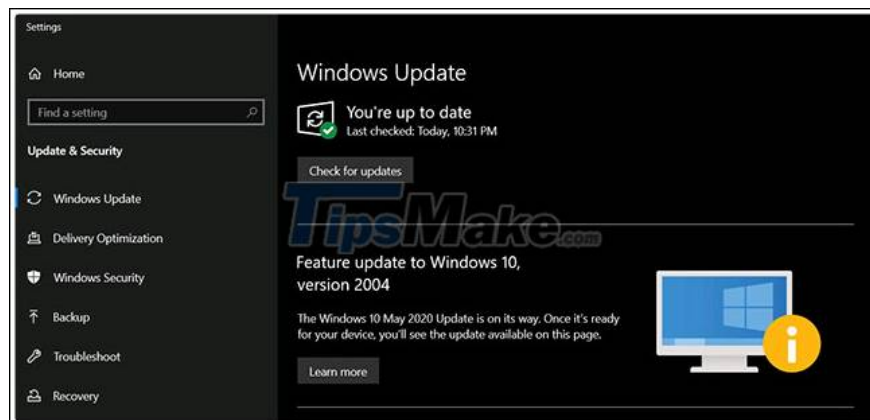


In some cases, however, users may not be able to click on the notification and download the latest feature update.

Microsoft may have stopped blocking the May 2020 Update / October 2020 Update on nearly all configurations. However, these feature updates haven't been delivered to some of those systems yet due to unknown security and compatibility issues. For this reason, Microsoft also committed to send a notification to users if their PC is not

ready to receive the latest upgrade from Microsoft. This notice reads as follows:

'The Windows 10 May 2020 Update is on its way. Once your device is ready, you'll see the update available on this page '.



If you don't see the option to install a feature update or have trouble with Windows Update vague notifications, it's still possible to update your device manually.

Turn off 'Your version of Windows 10 will reach the end of service' message

To get rid of this automatic notification and upgrade your system to the latest version, you can use the Update Assistant tool.

This tool will download the entire operating system package (version 20H2) and it will start the standard installation process instead of using the Windows Update installer. Note that your updates might still be blocked if there's a major compatibility issue.
