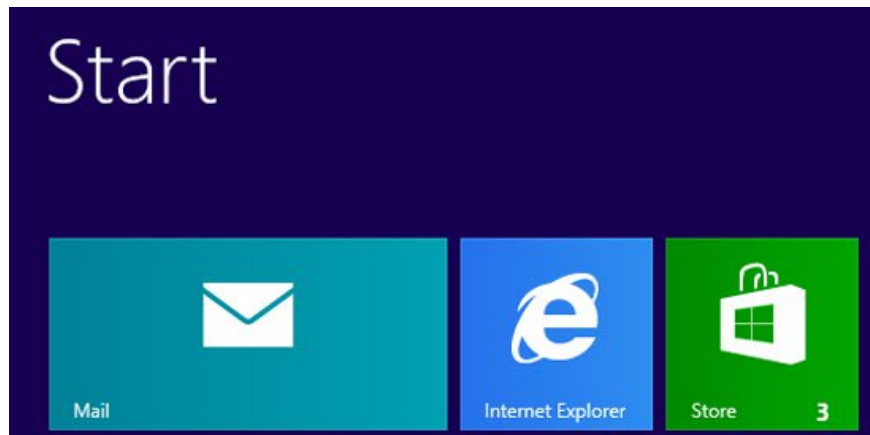

In the coming weeks, the "software giant" will update applications such as Mail, Photo, Maps, SkyDrive, Bing, Finance, News, Sports, Travel, Weather, Video, Music and Games before the release of Windows 8 on October 26, 2012.

Microsoft said it will provide updates for applications through the Windows Store. Users will see applications that have improved performance, reliability and some new capabilities.
