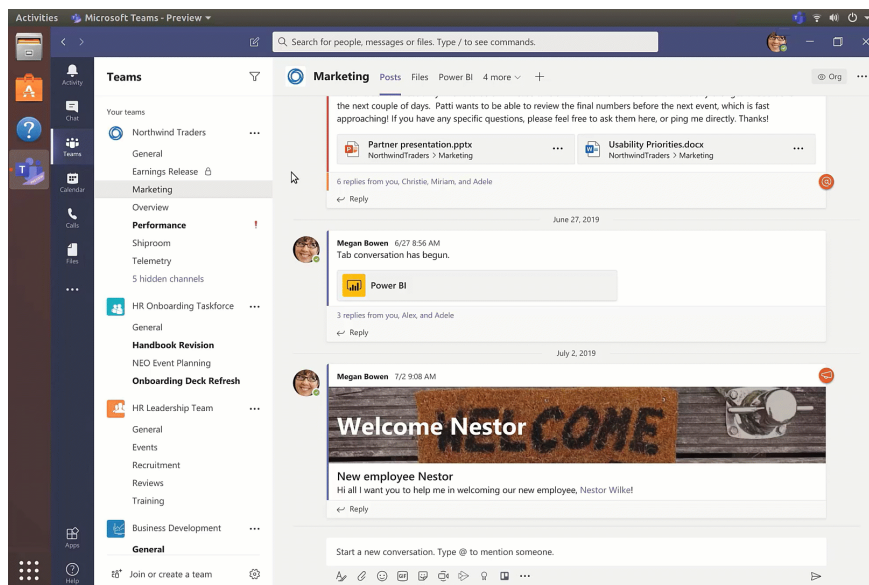


# Microsoft Teams is officially available on Linux

Microsoft claims Teams currently has 20 million active users. With this milestone, Microsoft Teams now has nearly twice as many active users as Slack, and has become one of the extremely important service platforms in Redmond's development strategy.
