

# Microsoft will merge 3 operating systems into one

Versions This update will help Microsoft consolidate its three operating systems into one, with the code name "*Threshold*".

At the same time, 3 operating systems will share an application store. For developers they will be provided with tools to write usable applications for all three platforms.



The leaked news also coincides with the plan that *CEO Steve Ballmer* - who is about to retire at Microsoft - shared a little while ago in a letter to corporate shareholders. *Ballmer* said that "*Microsoft will bring a lot of high-value services to a wide range of devices of its own companies and partners.*" In the launch of the

company restructuring in July, Ballmer also mentioned the ambition of "**One Microsoft**" plan with the content of their products and services to bring users an experience throughout, consistent on many different devices.

However, before "**Threshold**" is released, Microsoft will have other updates, including the update for Windows Phone with **Blue** code. This promises to be an update to make Windows Phone "*completely molting*", while helping to integrate Microsoft services more closely. In the field of PC, the possibility of a **Windows 8.1** update will be released in the second quarter of next year.
