

Microsoft will release Office 2019 next year

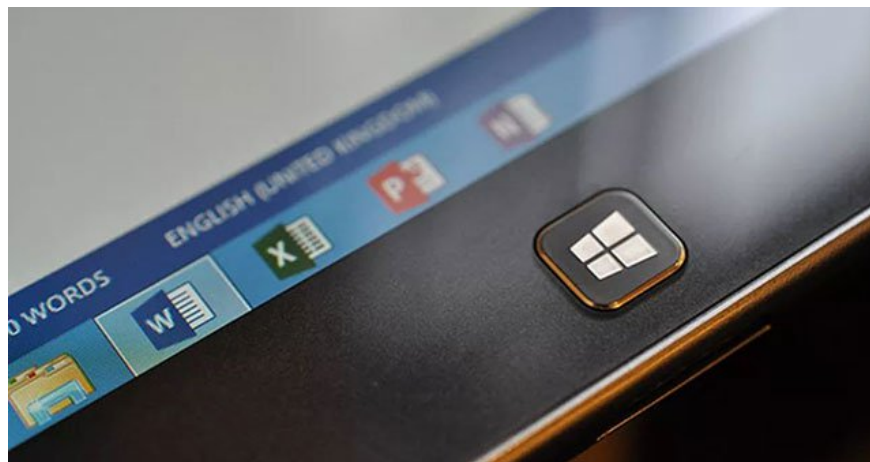
Today, Microsoft announced it will release the next version of Office with plans to update next year for Office 2019.

Today, at the Ignite conference in Orlando, Microsoft announced it would release the next version of Office with plans to update next year.

Office 2019 (to be released in the second half of 2018) will bring in familiar client applications like Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Outlook, along with server versions of Exchange, SharePoint and Skype for Business.

The company plans to release the Preview version of Office 2019 in mid-2018 and the software is designed primarily for organizations that do not use the version of Office 365 in the cloud.

Office 2019 will have better IT capabilities for businesses without Office 365, along with ink-related features for users on mobile devices such as pressure sensitivity, tilting and playback effects. . Excel also has new formulas and tables for data analysis. PowerPoint will include the effects and zoom tools that Office 365 users still have.

Microsoft said it will share more about Office 2019 in the coming months. In effect, if you are using Office 365, you are still using the latest features.
