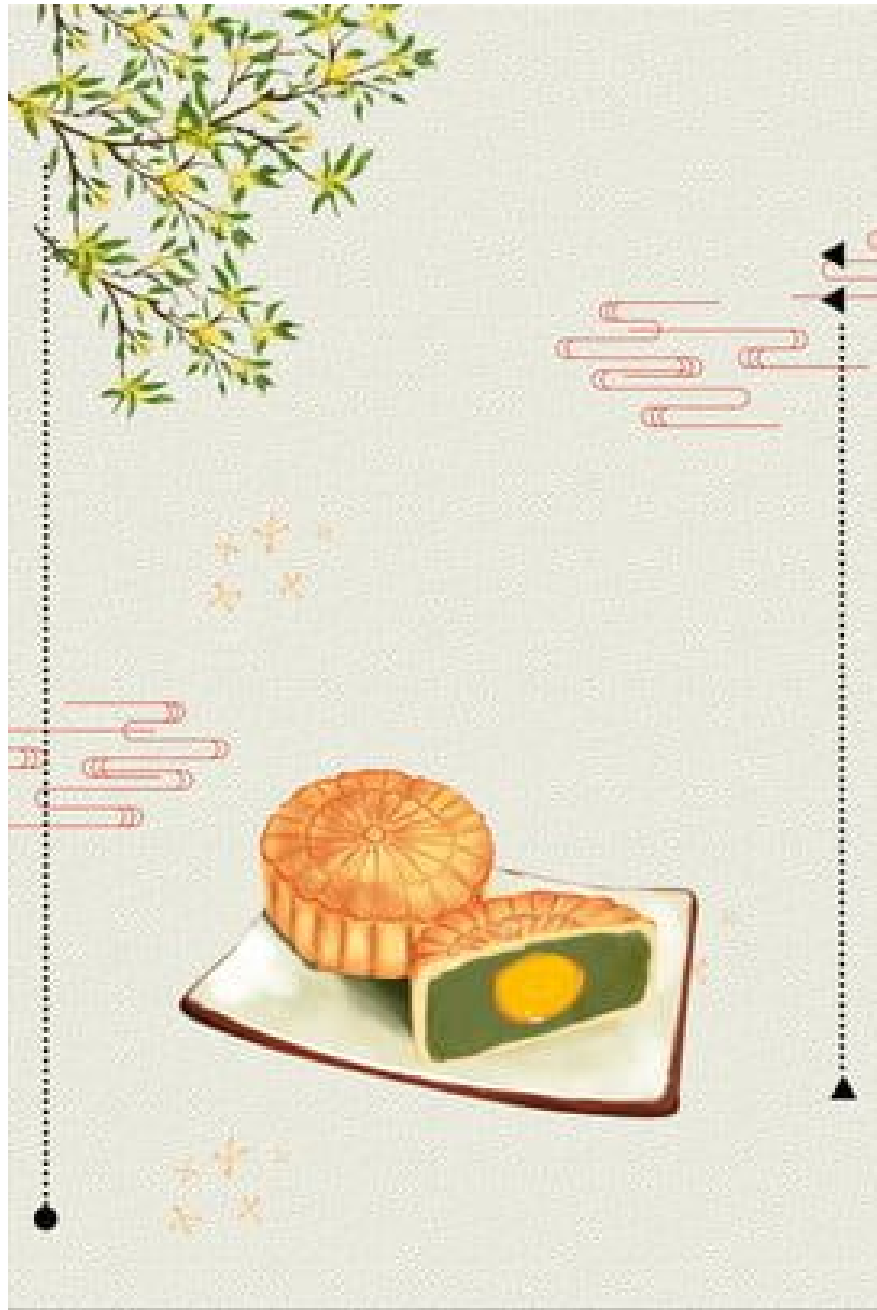






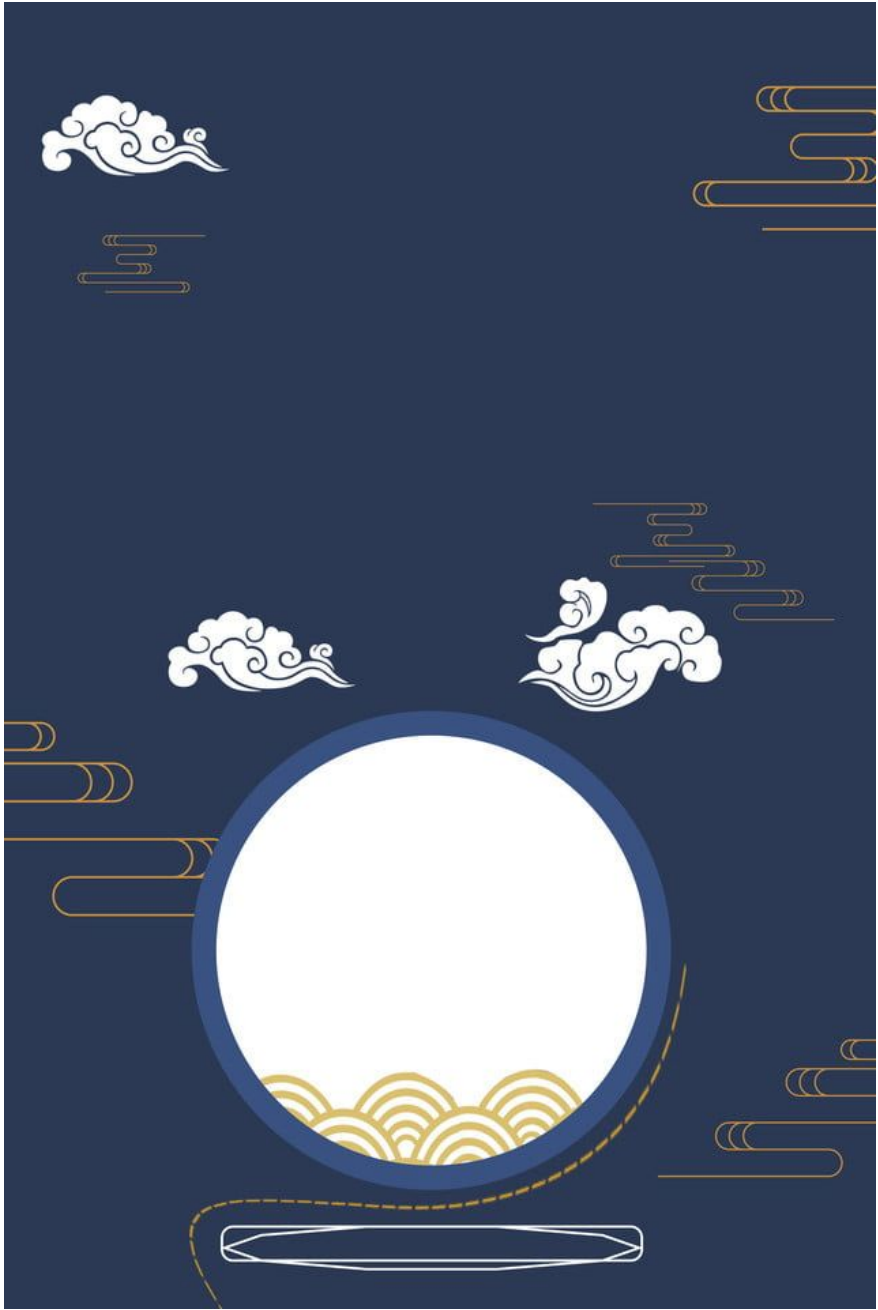




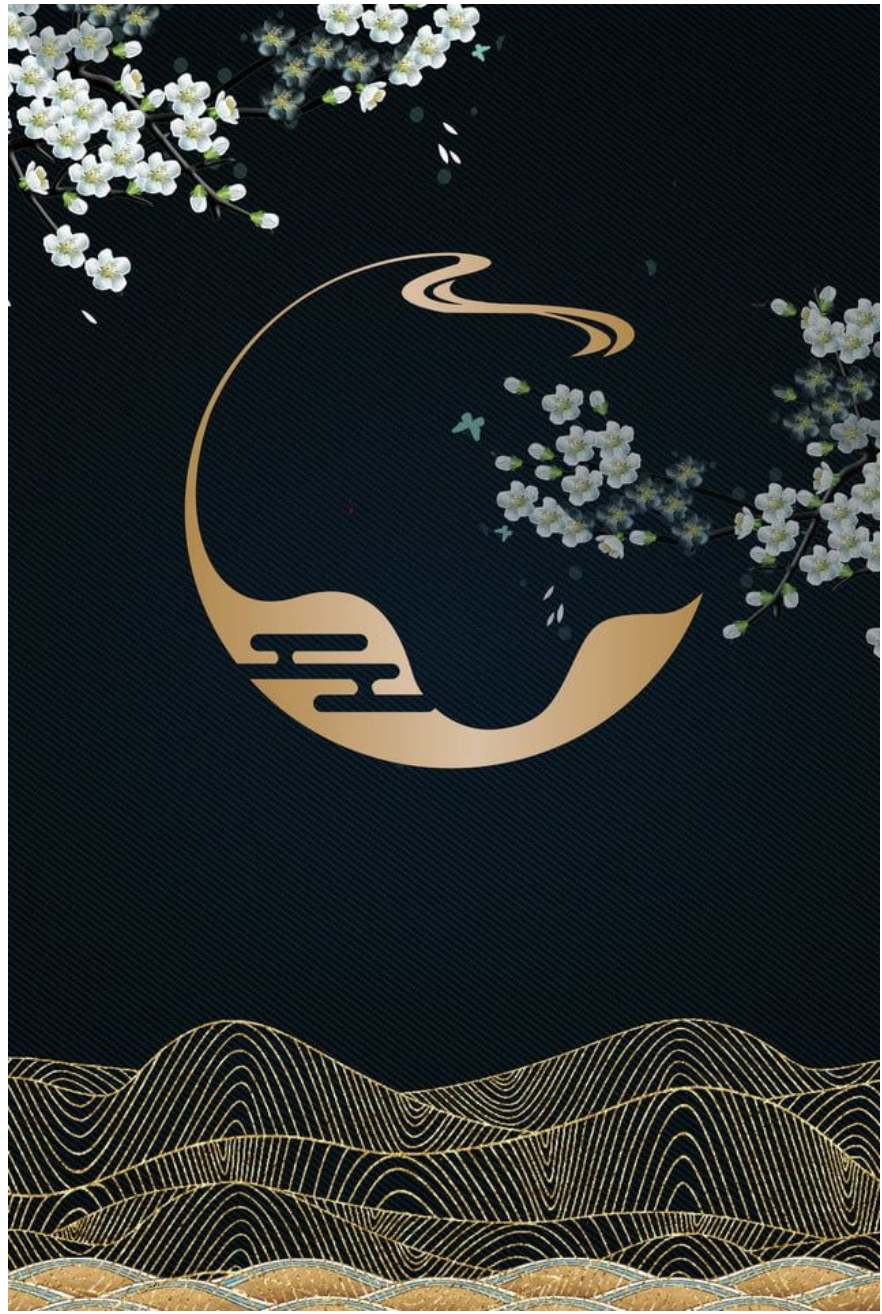


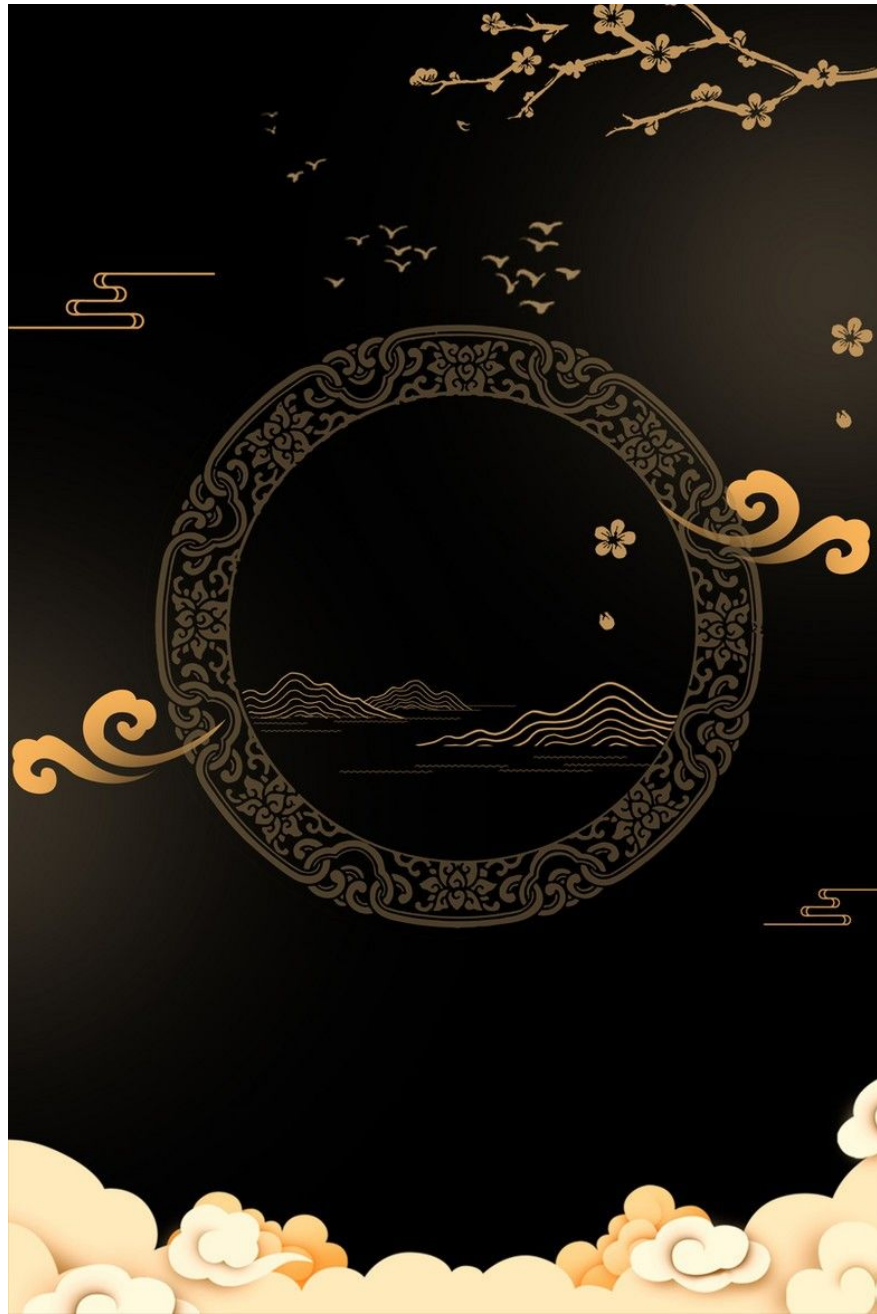












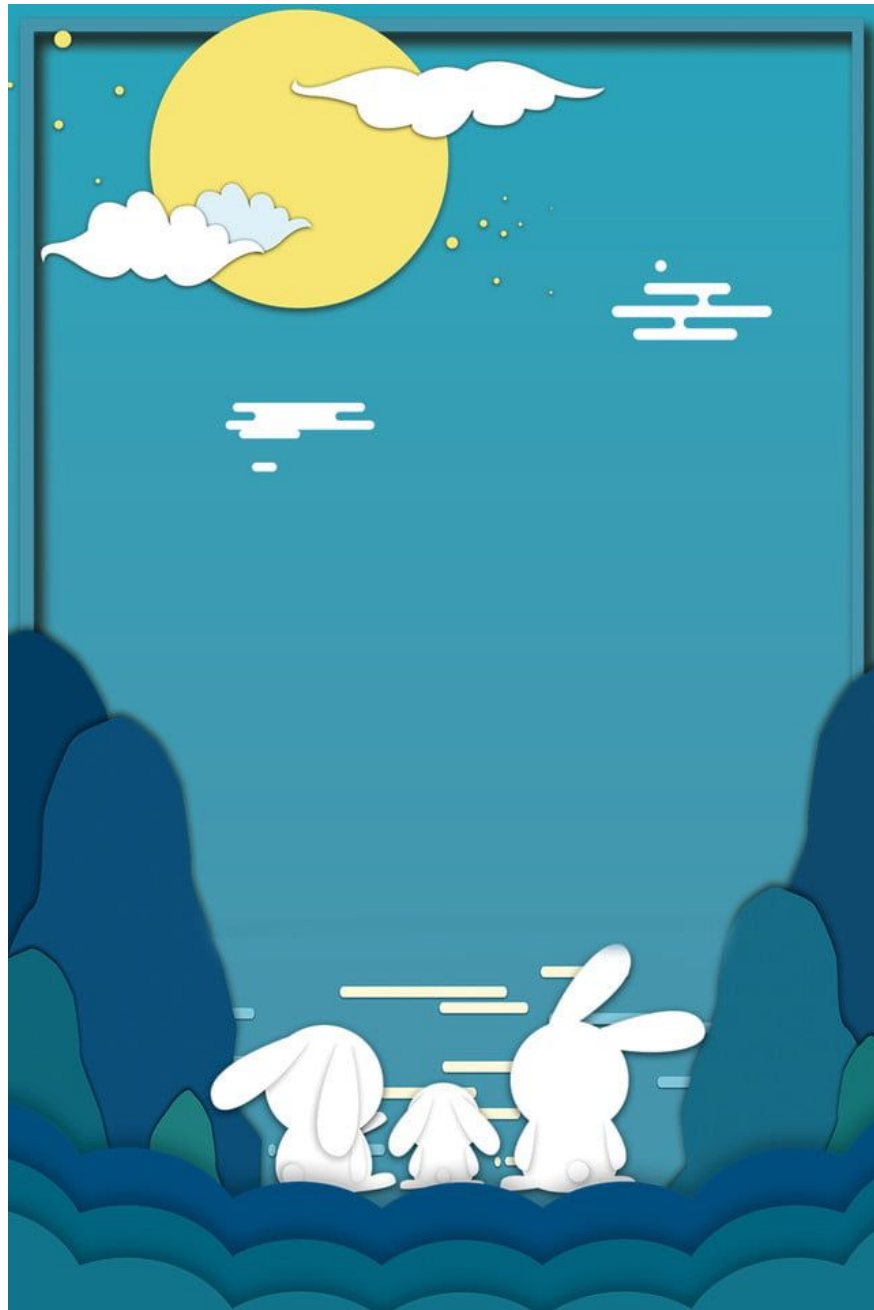


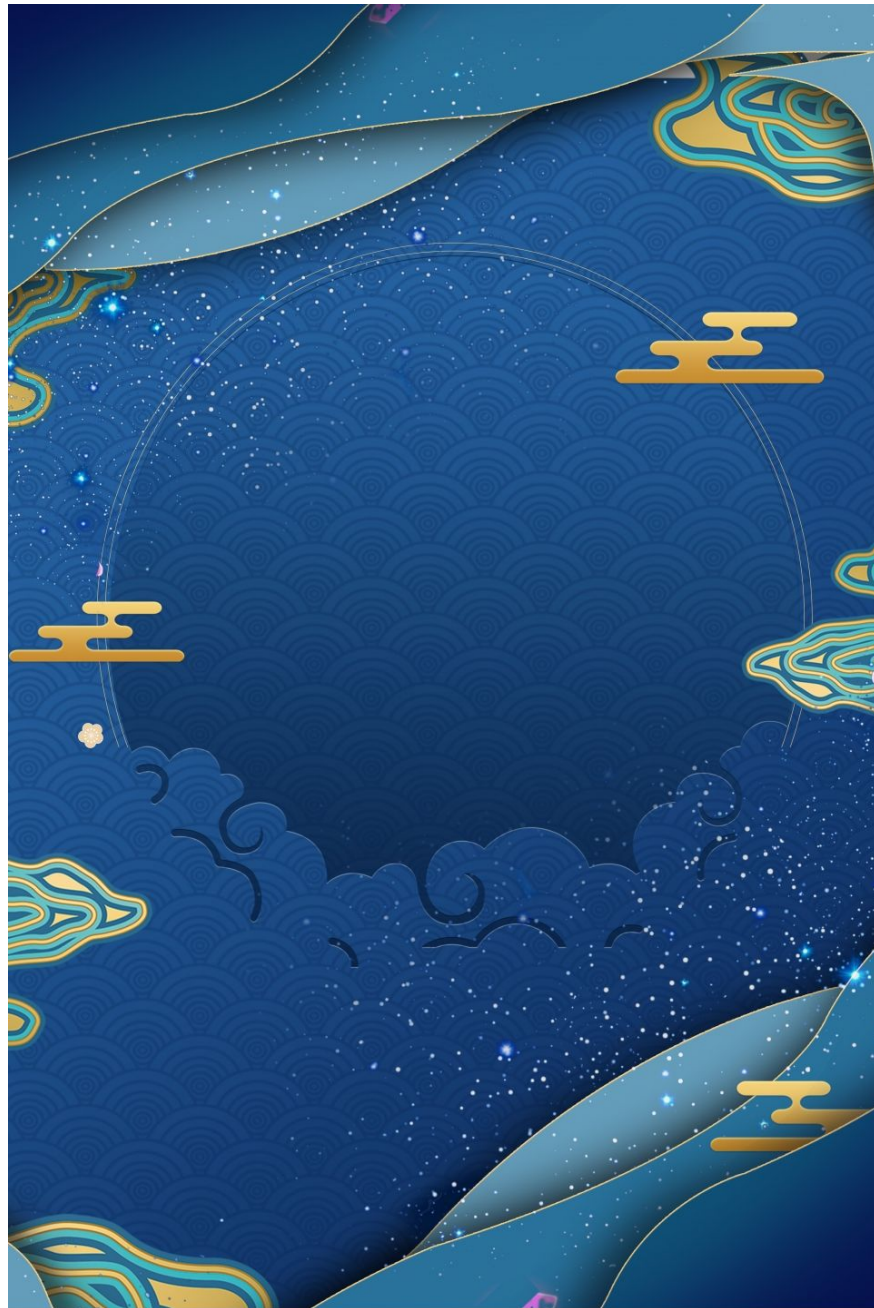


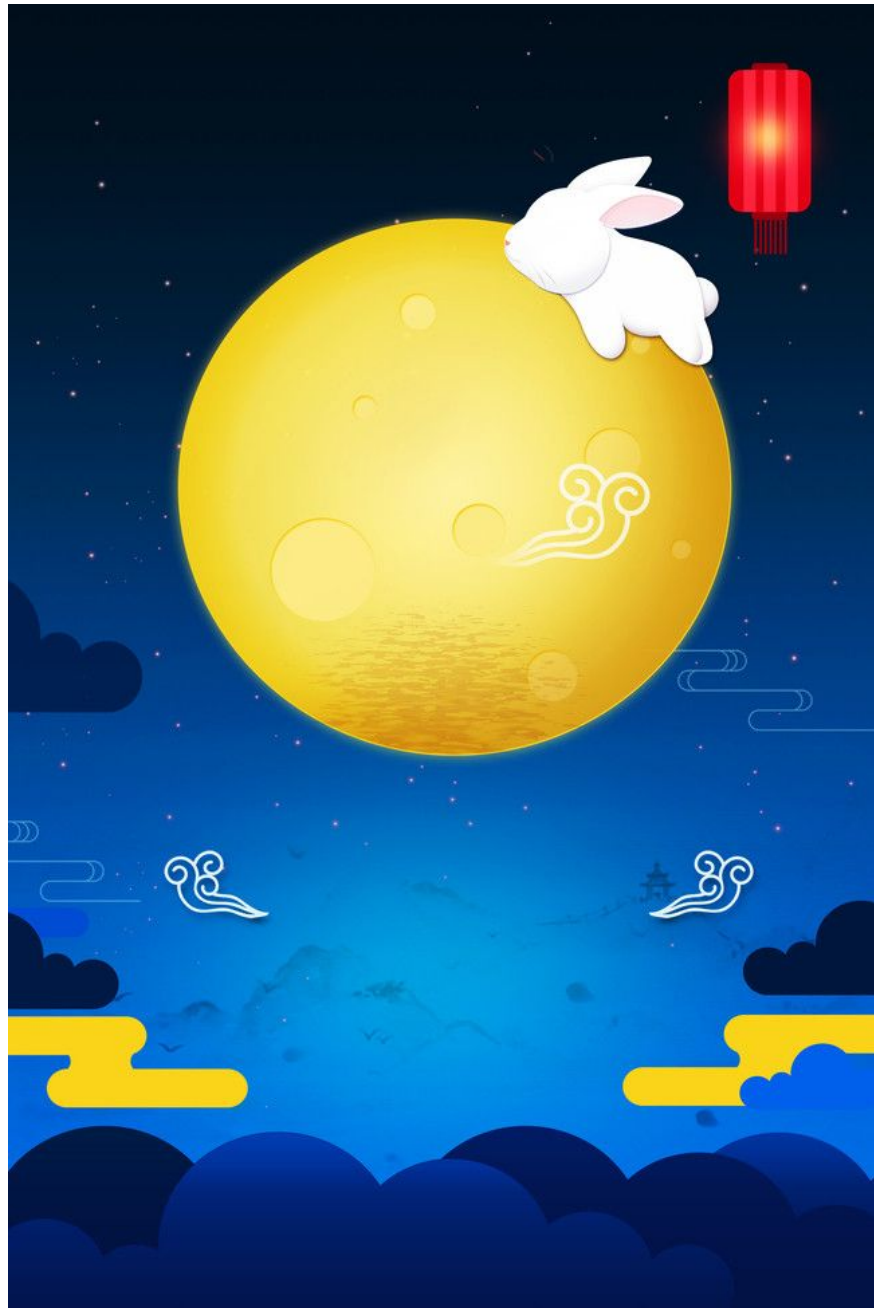


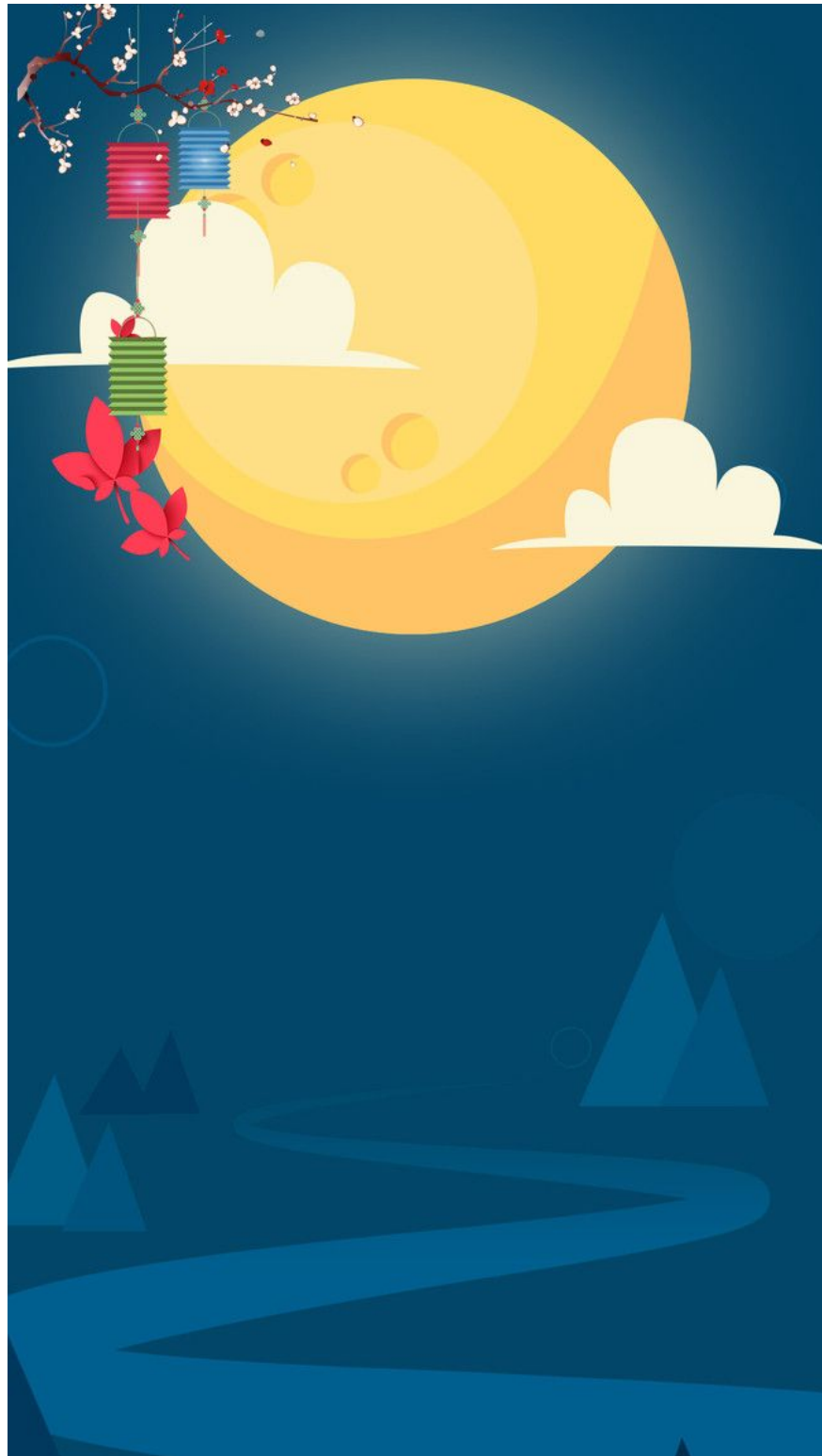














**During the Mid-Autumn Festival, several characters are frequently mentioned, including:**
