

Minecraft: How to find biome

Minecraft: How to find biome populations, Minecraft has many types of biomes with different materials for players to collect.

But with its 'difficult' feature, not everything in Minecraft is easy to find. Therefore, the following guide will help players find biomes quickly.

How to find any biome in Minecraft

There are two ways to find every biome in this sandbox game: using console commands or using the online biome finder. People can use these two methods to locate both normal and rare biomes, including mesa, jungle, and mushroom biomes.

Using commands in the console

In the Java version of Minecraft, players can use in-game commands to find specific biomes on the map. It is also the easiest way to locate the desired biome quickly.



Everyone just needs to use the /locationbiome command in the game. Then the desired biome from the list of options in the pop-up window. After clicking Enter, it will locate the population of creatures closest to the character.

Use an online biome finder

If not playing in Java Edition, console command will not help to find biome. But there are still many biome finder online on the internet. Like other games' interactive maps, this tool helps Minecraft players locate the

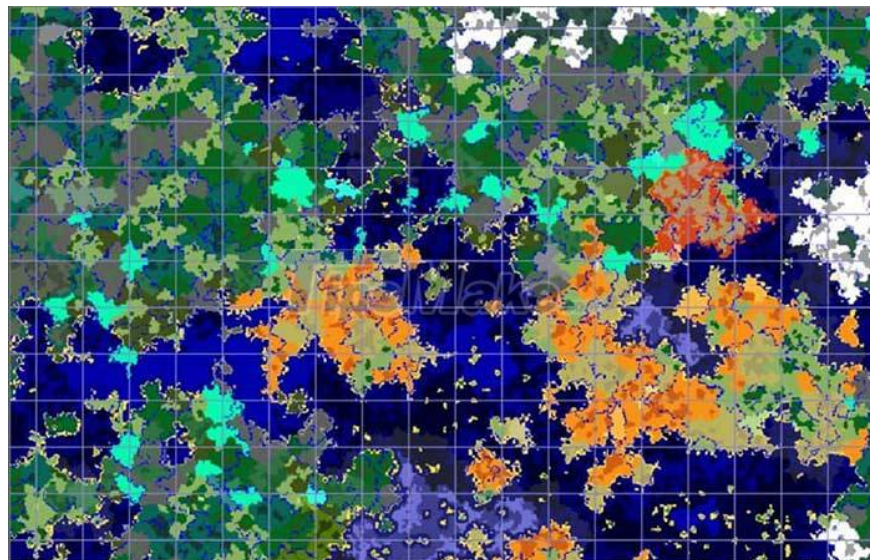
desired biome at a glance.



Minecraft players can use an online biome finder like CHUNKBASE. This is a useful tool to find Minecraft biome quickly.

All people need to do is enter the seed of the world they are interested in to find a biome in it. Select your world version and make sure it's Bedrock Edition.

From there, the entire map of the game world will be generated and the player can look through until he finds the coordinates for the biome he is looking for. The tool will generate a world map of the imported seed and will display all biomes.



Players can identify biomes by looking at their colors on the seed map. Warm biomes like desert and badland are orange, while lush biomes like forest, swamp, jungle are green.

Similarly, other biomes also come in different colors. Gamers can hover over the area to see which biome it is and its coordinates.

The gamer can then return to his game world and trace his way to the desired location using the coordinates just provided.

The method of using CHUNKBASE works for both Java Edition and Bedrock of Minecraft and will be the most optimal way to find a specific biome for most players.

Information about special biomes in Minecraft

Some biomes in Minecraft are quite hard to find. Sometimes its common name is not the right name. Players may have some difficulty locating extremely rare biomes.

Mesa biome in Minecraft



Mesa biome is quite hard to find as it is one of the rarest biomes in Minecraft. This biome can only be found in the Overworld. Since Mesa is filled with red sand and terracotta color it is also known as Terracotta biome or Badlands

The player can see many rivers flowing through the red sand valleys, creating a color contrast between the warm color of the sand and the cold color of the river. This makes this biome no longer boring and makes many players hunt for it because the Gold Ore spawn rate here is higher.



Cactus and dead bushes are the only plants in this biome so logging is not possible here. Instead, the Mesa biome offers the player red sand and a variety of terracotta, rocks, and ores.

Jungle biome in Minecraft

Jungle biome is the most diverse and popular biome in this game. It comes in 7 variations with different woods. Therefore, players need to understand all types of forests well to know where to find the necessary wood.



For example, the regular forest will be more dangerous than the other types because the player must constantly fight against mobs; jungle biome provides both wood and animals, so you can explore this biome to tame the animals you want to raise,.

To find the Jungle biome in Minecraft, use the command `/locbiome`, then the list of biomes in the pop-up window. Scroll down to find Minecraft Jungle and click Enter. The game will bring the character to the location of the nearest forest biome.

Mushroom Biome in Minecraft



Mushrooms are another special biome in Minecraft. It was born in the Overworld just like Mesa. The player can find a large area of red and brown mushrooms growing on a variety of islands. Besides, the land of this biome is also covered with mycelium.

Mushrooms are the only plant species here, so it is not possible to find any plants on these islands. The weather in the mushroom biome has moderate rainfall, creating a humid environment for the growth of this organism.



In addition to red and brown mushrooms, the player can also mine stones and many other blocks, such as stones and ores. This biome is very dangerous at night. That is why players need to prepare thoroughly to destroy all mobs, such as spiders, creepers, skeletons, Endermen, witches and zombies. Also, people can only find Mooshrooms in mushroom biomes.
