

Mistakes when using a password

Users sometimes make very common mistakes and need to reconsider to protect online accounts:

Use a password for every account

As more and more online services become available, users tend to use a password for multiple accounts to make it easier to remember. This is the gap for those who guess and exploit their " *world* ".

The solution is that they must immediately switch to special, difficult-to-guess passwords for each account. At the very least, they need to be careful with accounts related to money and private information.

Use a common password

Many users have very " *rudimentary* " passwords such as 123456, password, password, date of birth, ID card number, character sequences arranged on the keyboard, phone number . These are passwords that testers try First, the more you use them, the greater the probability of being exposed.

The solution is to think of very complex passwords, preferably with special characters combined with Shift keys, to turn it into something that is still easy to remember. For example: | / | @ _ | _ K | - | @ | _ | (password).

Names

The familiar names around you can also be a test of bad guys, for example, parents, lovers, spouses, first love, even name . pet.

It is best to stay away from all types of mf names using a combination of both numbers and numbers, and special characters.

Write passwords to paper

Many people who were not confident in their memory carefully wrote out the account paper with which password and then stuffed it into the desk drawer. This will make you " *empty* " if the small paper falls into the hands of a bad person.

The solution is to avoid such types of paper. If you don't remember well, you should write to a text file and encrypt it with a complicated password. Your task is now to remember only one password of that file.

Ignore security software

People who regularly use online accounts for banking or online payments always work with large amounts of money. However, many computers do not install software to detect viruses, Trojans, spyware . or just use " *temple* " goods.

Currently there are many reputable security products that are sold at affordable prices, 200-300 thousand VND / year and have accompanying support services. This amount of towering nothing compared to the risk of losing money from spyware stealing account information.
