Learn the basic gameplay

The core gameplay of the Monster Hunter series has been consistent over the decades, and the tradition continues in Monster Hunter Rise. The process of each game is very simple:

1. Choose a single monster to fight.
2. Travel to a vast land where there are monsters.
3. Find your goal.
4. Fight the creature solo or with a few friends.
5. Craft new armor and equipment from your hunted prey.
6. Repeat the process.



At the beginning of the game, everyone will be led around their base to meet other citizens as they teach about each function.

In the process of doing that, everyone will go on their first hunting trip and get a lot of guidance regarding some of the basics of the game.

When returning to their village, gamers will be shown how to turn parts obtained from defeated monsters into new equipment.

People will continue this process as the game increases in difficulty. Over time, when more familiar with Monster Hunter Rise, gamers will begin to optimize their equipment for the next hunt. Players will choose specific equipment to overcome increasingly stronger monsters.

Do the practice quest first

There are some basics before fully diving into Monster Hunter Rise. The basic training mission helps the player to gain a deeper understanding of the game's system.

Before starting tough battles with monsters or playing online with friends, complete these short quests. While most of what gamers need to know will be displayed in the pop-up notifications, hands-on experience is always best.



After meeting Master Utsushi at the Gathering Hub, he will add a few training quests to the list of Hinoa the Quest Maiden in the village. While these tasks can be easy to overlook, they are well worth the effort.

These tasks will cover several important topics:

1. Back to Basics takes gamers through the main gameplay mechanics of Monster Hunter Rise.
2. Learning to Ride teaches how to drive a Wyvern. This is an important skill to learn as it will greatly reduce hunting time.
3. The Basics of Capturing Monsters teaches how to end quests by trapping monsters instead of defeating them. Capturing creatures can complete the hunt much faster and will also allow access to unique monster parts. If you want to learn how to forge the best armor and weapons, gamers need to learn this skill.
4. The Rampage Approaches shows you how to play Rampage mode in Monster Hunter Rise.

Always eat dango before hunting



The important thing before hunting is to visit the canteen to eat dango. As you progress in Monster Hunter Rise, people will unlock new dishes to combine and create buffs for each hunt. Familiarize yourself with each monster's elemental types and order dango recipes that help fend off your target's special attacks.

If you play Monster Hunter Rise long enough, the cost of ordering a dango will be negligible, especially if paid for by the abundant points gained by simply hunting. There's no reason not to eat dango before every hunt. Its buffs can make or break certain goals.
