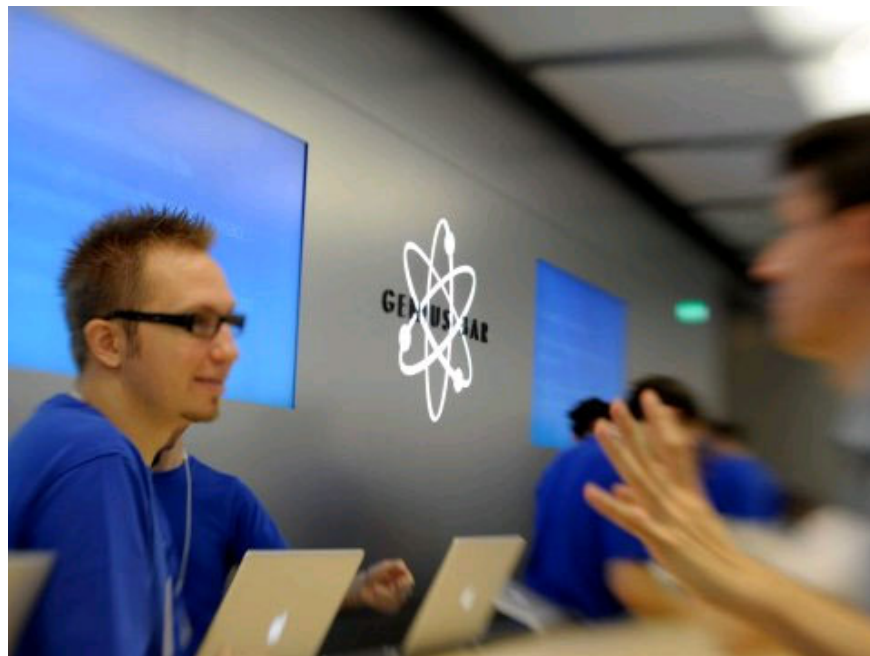


More than 20,000 former employees sued Apple for not paying wages
