According to *GSMarena* , the above information was revealed by *Rick Osterloh* , Motorola's vice president of product management. In particular, the cheap smartphone Moto G is the model with the highest sales volume.

Motorola also " *acknowledged* " the company is on the right track to participate in the cheap smartphone market, as evidenced by sales in the first quarter of 2014 of 6.5 million units.

Reportedly, the **Moto G** model uses 4.5-inch screen with HD resolution, using Snapdragon 400 processor with 1.2 GHz speed, 1 GB RAM, 8 GB of internal memory, 5 MP rear camera, 1.3 MP front camera and pre-installed latest Android 4.4 KiKat version of Google.

In the US, the Moto G model sells for only \$ 180.

Information experts also said that Motorola will continue to *"stir"* the cheap smartphone market by launching the **Moto E** smartphone model using 4.3-inch screen, 1.2 GHz dual-core processor, RAM 1 GB, 4 GB of internal memory and will sell for less than the Moto G. model.
