

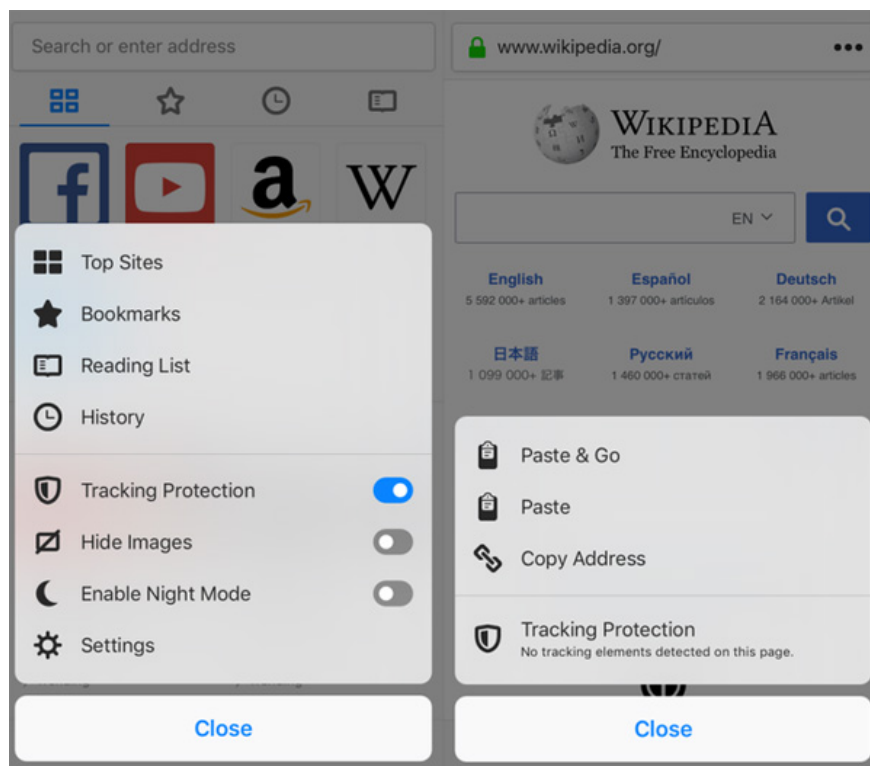
Mozilla launched Firefox 11.0 for iOS, which turned on anti-tracking by default

Recently, Mozilla has released the Firefox 11.0 update for iOS, allowing users to change the default of default time tabs to enable tracking protection.

Anti-tracking feature

Anti-tracking feature allows Firefox to block elements that can track you while surfing the web on websites such as ads, analytics monitors, and social sharing buttons . Ads don't follow Users are still allowed to display. The anti-tracking feature on Firefox for iOS will be turned on by default, users can optionally turn on / off for each page by holding down the address bar and clicking on the shield icon.



This new feature not only helps protect users' privacy, but also helps improve Firefox's performance (web content will be downloaded faster, use less data and thereby increase battery life).

Rearrange tabs

With Firefox 11.0 version, iOS users can also easily rearrange tabs by pressing and holding on any tab and dragging it left or right.

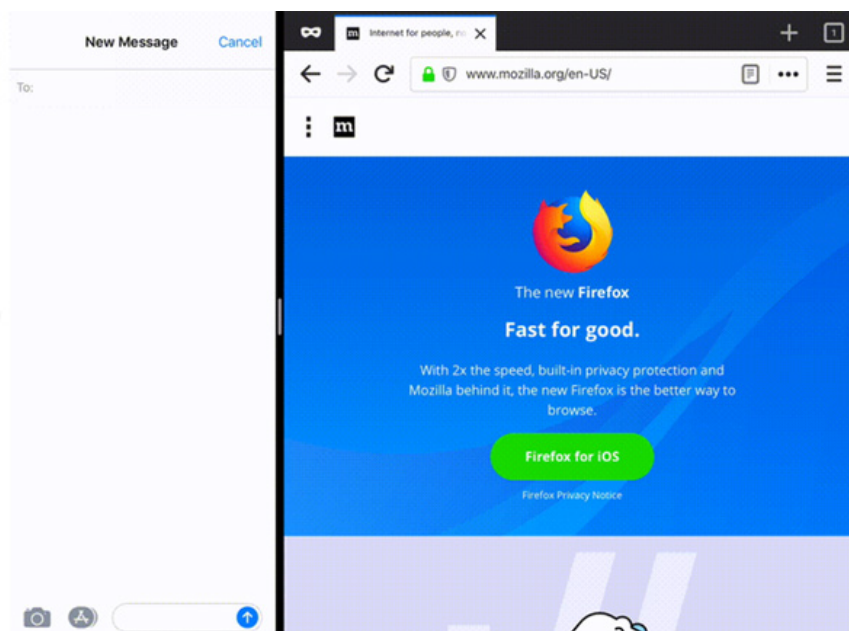
Share URL

In the new version, users can easily share URLs while using any other iOS application by dragging and dropping links into or out of Firefox. If you're using the iPad in dual-screen (side-by-side) mode, simply drag the link or tab into another application.

Users can open the dock or application switch (app switcher), then drag the link to other applications until the app icon bounces and releases the link. Then the other application will open the link you just dragged.

Add some new shortcuts on the iPad

Firefox 11.0 for iOS dedicated iPad has some new shortcuts, including standard navigation keys from the desktop.
