

My Hero Academia: The Strongest Hero - Reroll guide to the best start

My Hero Academia: The Strongest Hero is an action role-playing gacha game where players can freely play with their favorite heroes from the popular manga/anime series, in the context of action-packed combat. real time.

The game owns heroes from My Hero Academia such as Izuku Midoriya, All Might, Ochako Uraraka, Denki Kaminari, Fumigake Tokoyami,.

My Hero Academia: The Strongest Hero has a hero gathering element. This is the gacha aspect, which requires the player to summon their favorite characters through the summoning banner. The game offers an auto-selecting mode for the battle group, which is built-in with the AI in charge. All wars are done by heroes.



However, keep in mind that there is no automatic feature when playing in real-time PvP where gamers have to play their own group of heroes by controlling them.

My Hero Academia: The Strongest Hero features characters of different rarity levels, which can be obtained either as whole or as shards through the summoning feature. Having good characters to start with will play an important role throughout the gameplay. Therefore, this article will guide reroll to get the best start in My Hero Academia: The Strongest Hero.

Characters you should own when you start playing My Hero Academia: The Strongest Hero

Players can summon their favorite heroes with increased drop rates during certain event banners, which require special summoning currency. Players should own an S-rank character, although the probability is very low at

1.2%. Let's take a look at some recommended heroes:

Fumigake Tokoyami: Tokoyami is an absolute monster in PvP modes. His Dark Shadow superpower creates a shadow monster that can materialize and freeze enemies. Skill that specializes against heroes like Ochako using Dark Tornado to take her down. Overall, this is a solid DPS unit and well worth collecting.



Momo Yaoyorozu: Momo is another top S-rank unit in the game. The Creation superpower allows her to create any non-living object. Momo can create bazookas and cannons, varying from ranged to melee depending on the weapon.



All Might: All Might is the main superhero in the anime, as well as in My Hero Academia: The Strongest Hero. The One For All superpower greatly amplifies his physical damage from auto attacks, as well as abilities.

This is a must-have character for all modes, PvE or PvP, and also a nuclear weapon that maintains DPS. The ability allows All Might to be invincible for a few seconds, helping him stay alive and counterattack with powerful combos.



Shota Aizawa: Aizawa is a unique character with special strengths for PvP. Aizawa's superpower Erasure cancels enemies' superpowers if they are in a straight line with the character.

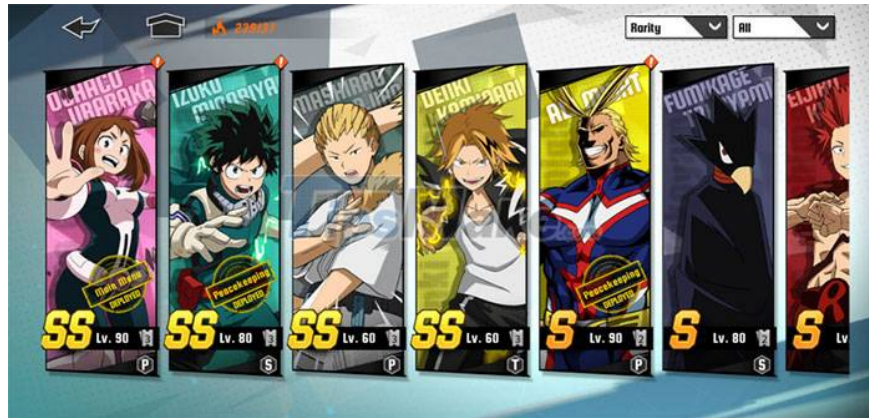


Instructions for rerolling in My Hero Academia: The Strongest Hero

Reroll is an essential part of games with gacha elements, where a good start is important and can establish a smooth journey throughout the game.

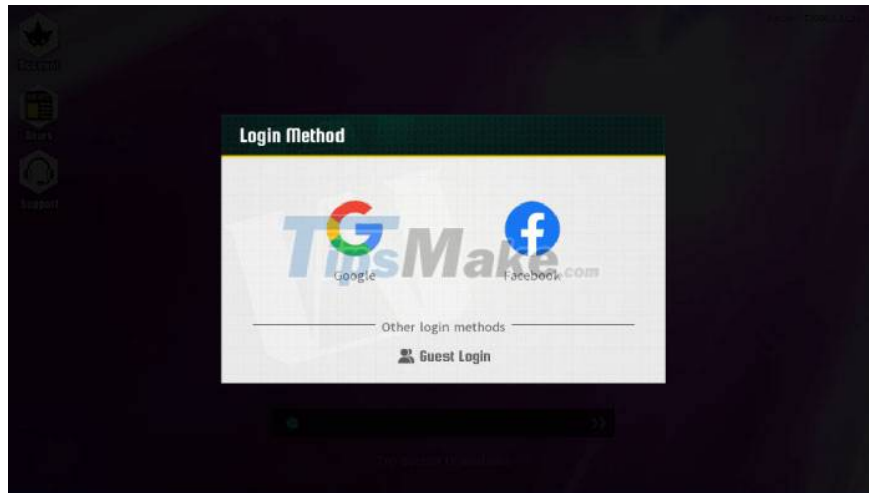
Playing My Hero Academia: The Strongest Hero on the BlueStacks emulator eases the reroll process by using the Multi-Instance Manager tool.

In My Hero Academia: The Strongest Hero, gamers can get enough coins to summon 10 times after completing the beginner's guide and collecting all the rewards from the mailbox.



The highest tier heroes have an S Rated that players should collect, especially those on the list above.

If one of these heroes cannot be obtained, simply restart the account creation process. Always remember to sign in with a guest, unlinked account, or sign in with your Google or Facebook account.



First, close the game and open File Manager on your device. Go to Phone Storage > Android > OBB folder and search for MHA TSH OBB folder. Rename the OBB folder.

Go to device settings > Apps > MHA TSH and clear the app's data. Go back to where you renamed the folder and rename it back to its original name.

Now open the game again and all content has been removed. This is the safest method without reloading from scratch.

Another possible way is to change the server and create a new account on another server. People can create multiple accounts in My Hero Academia: The Strongest Hero, one account per server.
