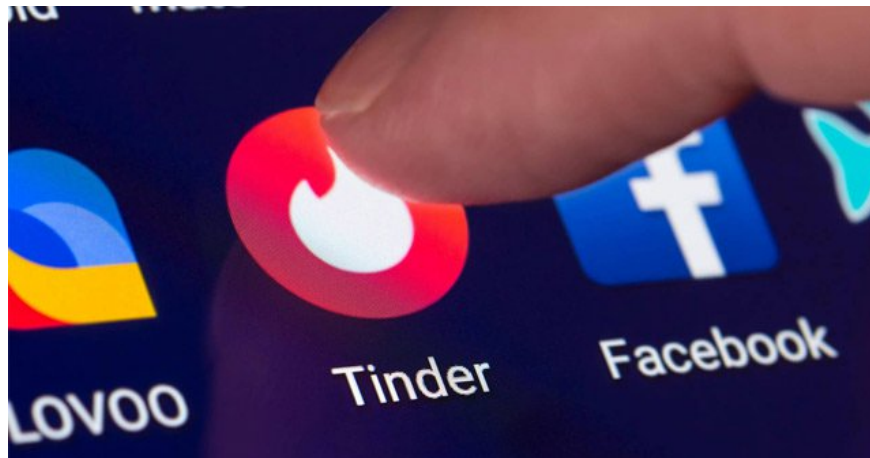


My wife went on a business trip, too lonely, the husband downloaded the dating app to 'watch and play' and accidentally met his wife here
