This new technology will be called *Google Cloud Print* . Using Google Cloud Print, users will no longer have to install printer paths to print from Web, desktop or mobile applications through intermediate Chrome OS web hosting services.

Mike Jazayeri, Google's product manager, said: *'Instead of printing with local operating systems or paths, applications can use Google Cloud Print to place print orders and manage print jobs. material. Google Cloud Print sends a print job to the appropriate printers along with the user-selected command. After that, Google Cloud Print will transfer the print status information to the application '.*

Although Google Cloud Print is in the early stages of design, Google wants designers and manufacturers to be interested in this new technology and work together in developing Google Cloud Print. Google launched Chrome OS open source in November last year. The first netbooks running the operating system are expected to "make things" on the market later this year.

Chrome OS is designed based on cloud computing, so Chrome OS will only run on Web hosting applications. The question is, how does Chrome OS interact with devices (such as printers)?
