

## New tips to distinguish iPad series

All Apple tablets simply represent the iPad text on the back of the device. It is not clear whether the iPad 2, New iPad or iPad with Retina display have made it difficult for many users to choose the right iPad version, especially with identical tablet designs like iPad 2 and New iPad .

Not specifying whether "iPad 2", "New iPad" or "iPad with Retina display" has made it difficult for many users to choose the right iPad version, especially with identical tablet designs. like iPad 2 and New iPad.**

However, there is still a way for users to accurately identify the iPad version, which is based on the model number on the back of the product.



According to *TechHive* , large manufacturers often avoid cumbersome name printing on their products, but as simple as possible. Apple also does this on its tablet line of products by using only a single brand name for every iPad life, simply "**iPad**" , not with the number. self or another term to separate these tablet generations.

However, this simplicity can sometimes be detrimental to users, especially for those who are new to the iPad for the first time because they cannot know whether they are holding the first iPad or iPad of 4 new lives. Best. So how do you know that?

There is a simple way **based on the model number printed on the back of the iPad**. The number of modes will tell you exactly how much your iPad is, and exactly what version of your iPad supports wireless connectivity (Wi-Fi version or Wi-Fi and 3G versions). . This model number is different from SKU, SKU only provides information about storage capacity, colors and some other iPad parameters.

The model number is printed quite small below the back of the iPad and usually begins with the letter A and the next four digits. You can find this number on the back of the iPad and then look up the following table to know exactly what iPad information you are using.

One note you read is that the iPad 4 and iPad Mini versions can also be written with the letter "**MM**". This demonstrates that the version is equipped with the best mobile connection and is compatible with CDMA technology.

In addition, there is another way for you to distinguish the iPad series is to **open Settings**, select the **general settings (General)**, then **select device information (About)** and then see the information about the iPad being used. .
