1. Use Command Prompt to root out hated viruses

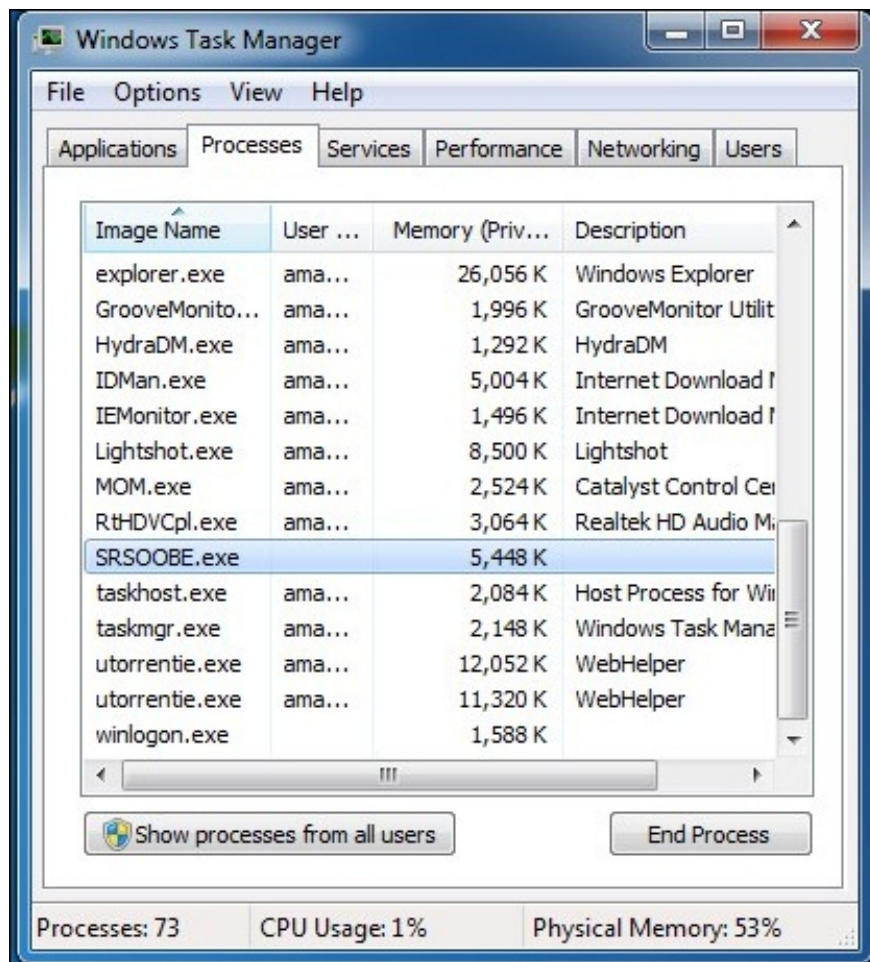
To remove the virus on your computer using the Command Prompt, you can refer to the steps here.

2. Disable Suspicious Services on Task Manager

To remove the virus by disabling Suspicious Services on Task Manager, follow the steps below:

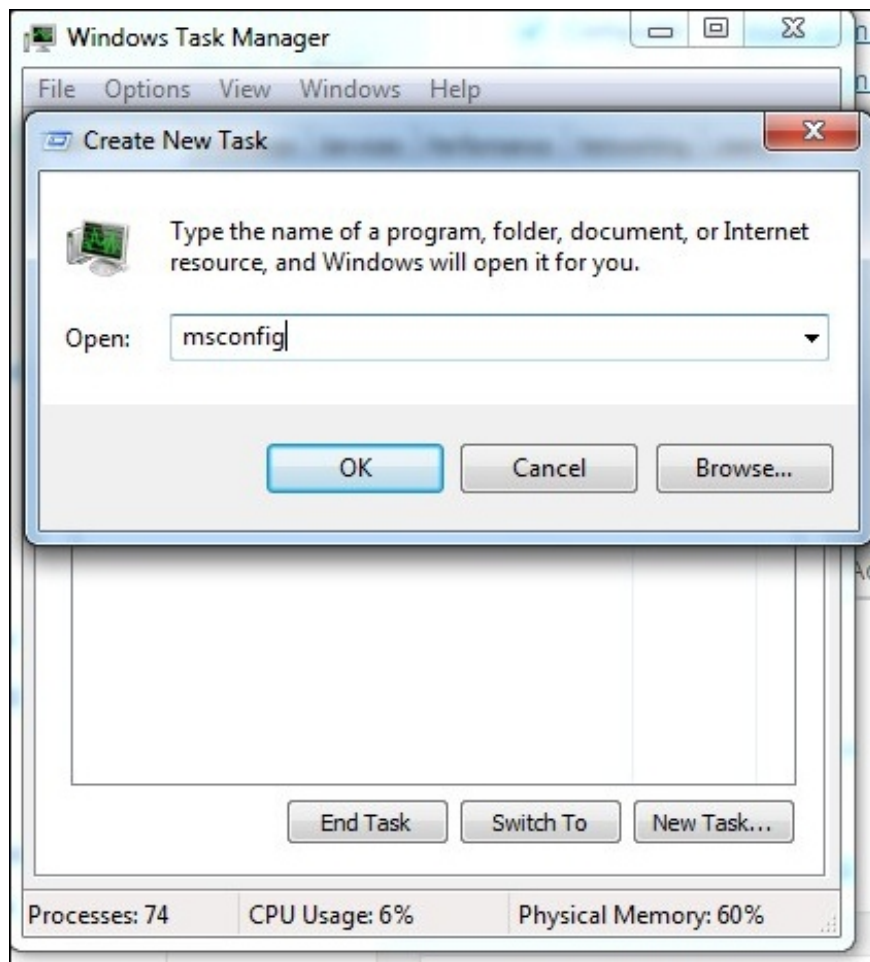
Step 1:

First open Task Manager by pressing **Ctrl + Shift + Esc** , then end all Suspicious Services in the Services tab.



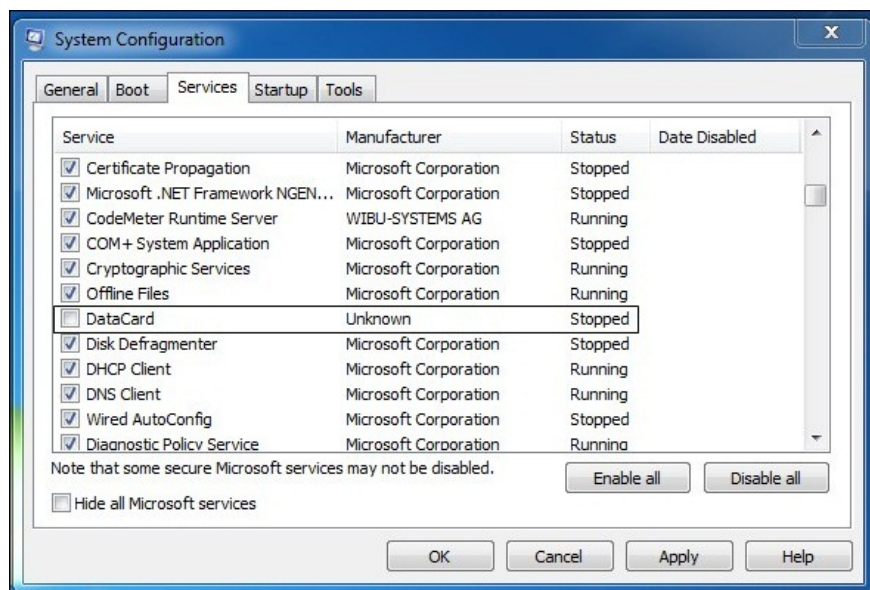
Step 2:

In the new Task, enter **MSConfig** .



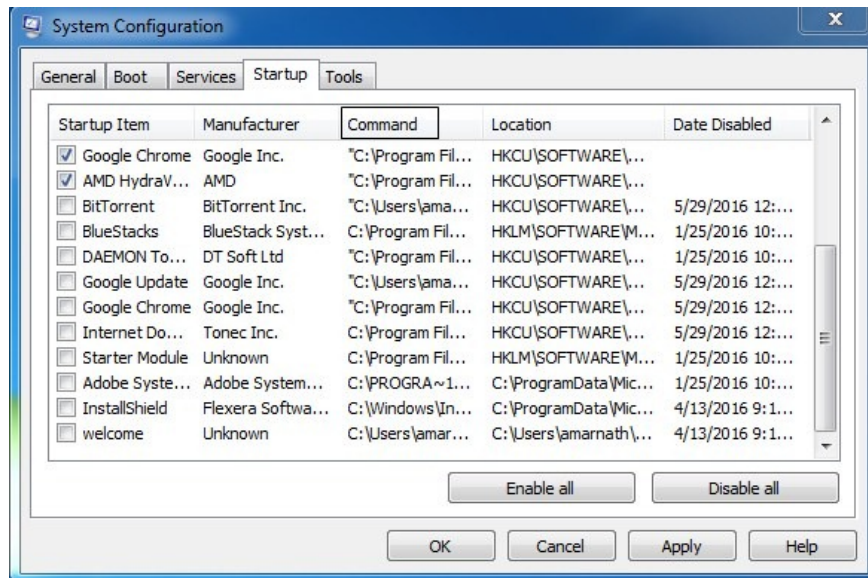
Step 3:

Next on the MSConfig window, access the **Service** tab, then uncheck any "suspicious" services or unwanted services.



Step 4:

Next click on the **Startup** tab. Search for any "weird" files or unwanted files in the Command section, where you will find the path of these "strange" files.



Finally open Command Prompt, then access the location of the "strange" files and change the properties of these files.

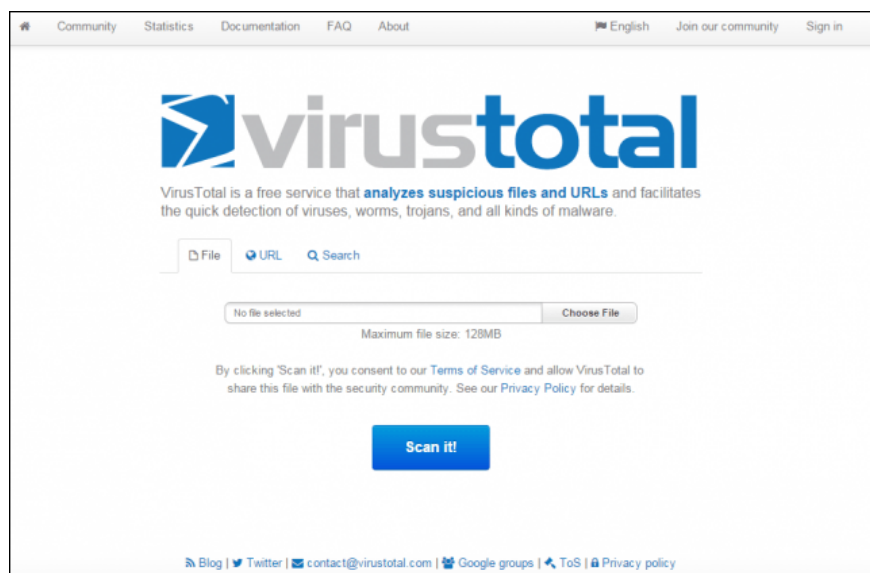
Refer to the steps to change the properties of the files here.

And finally, simply delete the files and finish.

3. Scan your system files using an online virus removal tool

Step 1:

Open any browser on your computer, then visit www.virustotal.com.



Step 2:

The next step is to select "weird" and "suspicious" files on your system to scan on Virustotal (maximum file sizes are 128 MB).



Step 3:

Also on Virustotal, you can scan a specific URL or even an entire website. Just enter the URL you suspect into the URL section on Virustotal.

After you've selected the files and URLs, click **Scan** to start the scanning process.
