

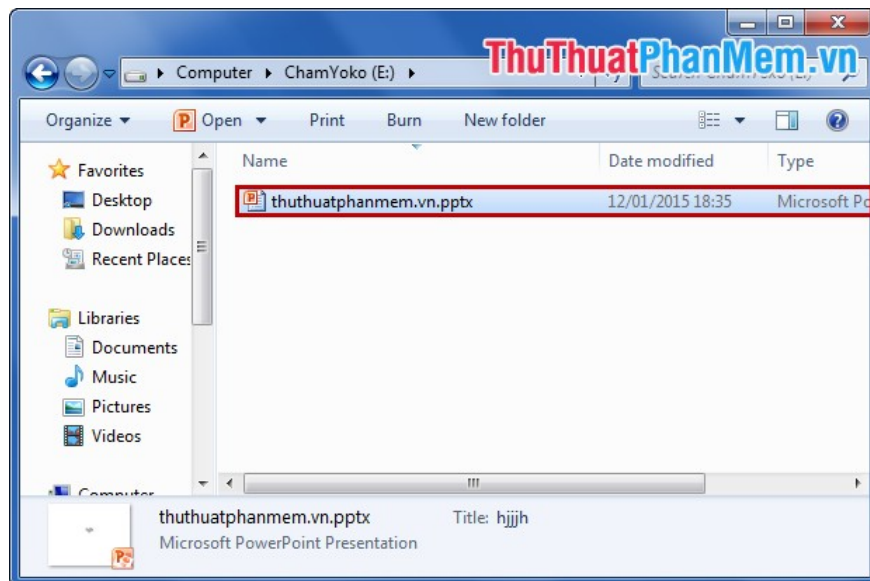
# Not for editing content in PowerPoint

The PowerPoint slideshows you create, you want to share with everyone but don't want them to copy or edit the content in that PowerPoint document.

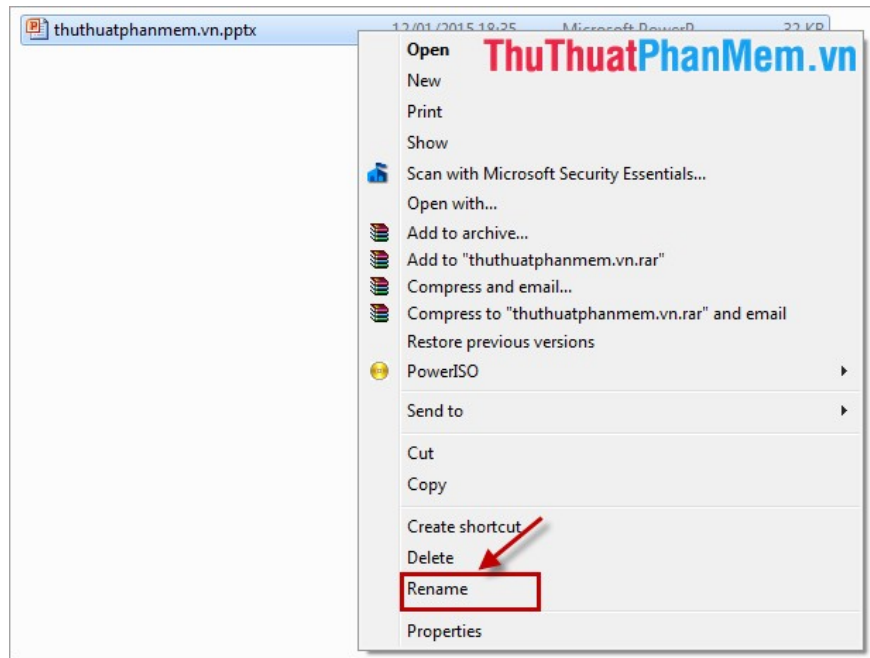

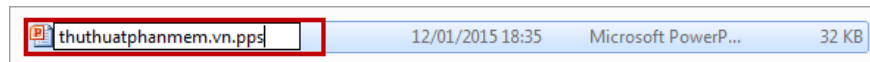
**Step 1:** Go to the folder containing the PowerPoint presentation you want to set up for editing content.



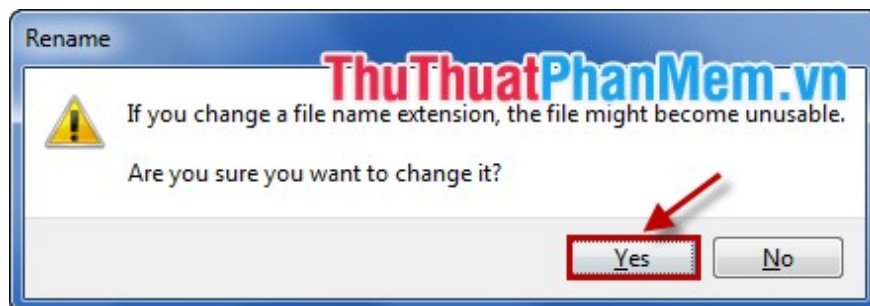
**Step 2:** Right-click the PowerPoint presentation file and select **Rename** (or press **F2** ).



**Step 3:** You change the extension from *.ppt* (PowerPoint 2007) and *.pptx* (PowerPoint 2010 and 2013) to *.pps* extension . Then press **Enter** or click on any empty position.



**Step 4:** A confirmation dialog appears, select **Yes** .



You can share this file, when opening up the slideshow will display in full screen mode (Full Screen) so it can not be edited. Good luck!
