This feature has been started by Evernote over the past few months but it has only been applied to a small number of Premium and Business users.

2-layer security is a security method that requires users to use up to 2 layers of passwords to log in to the service. In addition to the traditional password, users will be provided with a login code sent by Evernote via phone number. This way of making your account safer.

Evernote users can now use this feature. To activate, you access the **Security** section of **Evernote** web version and **click on the activation button of 2-layer password**. If you are a free user, you need to install another type of validation application like Google Authenticator.
