The history of Vietnamese Teachers' Day began with an international organization of progressive educators established in Paris (France) in July 1946 named **FISE** (Fédertion International Syndicale des Enseignants - United Nations). educational unions)

During the resistance war against French colonialism, **the Vietnam Education Union** expanded its relationship with FISE to enlist international support, denouncing the crimes of the aggressors against our people in general and with the teachers and students in particular.

In the spring of 1953, the Vietnam Delegation was led by Deputy Minister of National Education Nguyen Khanh Toan to attend the important meeting to enroll Education Union of some countries to organize FISE in Vienna (Austria's capital). , including Vietnam Education Union. Thus, only a short time after its establishment, Vietnam Education Union was admitted as a member of FISE.

From August 26 to August 30, 1975 in Warsaw (Poland), a FISE conference took place with 57 participating countries, including Vietnam Trade Union Education and decided to take on November 20 / 1958 is the day of the '*International Charter of Teachers*'. This day, it was first held in the northern region of our country in 1958. Years after this date was also held in the liberated areas in the south.

On September 28, 1982, **the Council of Ministers** (now the Government) issued Decision No. 167-HDBT set on November 20 every year as a holiday named "*Vietnam Teacher's Day*". November 20 has become the traditional day of Vietnam Education and associated with the customs of our country.

As a practice, on November 20, all schools in the country were enthusiastic about the activities performed by the students in the school such as: Arts performance, rally ceremony to celebrate Vietnamese Teachers' Day. , camp set up, flower arrangement . and many other meaningful activities.

And on these days all generations of students, as well as other professions in the society, take the time to share and appreciate the teachers and teachers who quietly quietly **devoted** their whole lives. for the country's growing people.
