

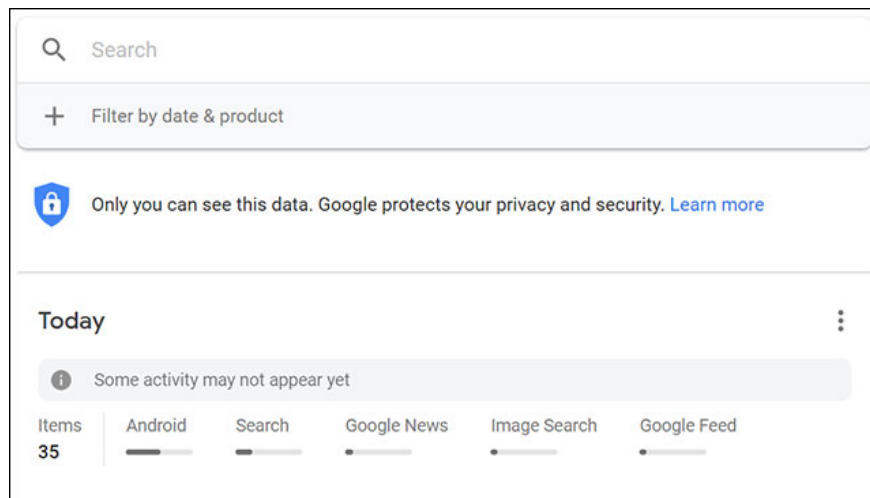
Now it is easy to delete Google search history

This enhanced privacy control will also be posted on Google Maps.

Using the power of the Google Search search engine also means that you have to trade off by sharing your data. Everything you enter into Google's search bar finds its way to Google's servers, where they are stored. Clearing your browsing history actually only deletes the data stored on your computer, but does not delete the data on Google servers.

Recently, Google Search has released a new feature that allows users to delete search history from the remote repository itself. Although it is clear that letting Google store search history helps the Google Search tool find more relevant results, but more users prioritize privacy and security.

On the new dashboard, Google will allow filtering by service and time. You just need to select Search below the filter and select delete all search history.

Today, this feature will be released on the Google Search desktop, Android and iOS apps will receive updates in the next few weeks. Besides this new control with Search, Google will also offer similar features on Maps so users can delete the data they want.
