

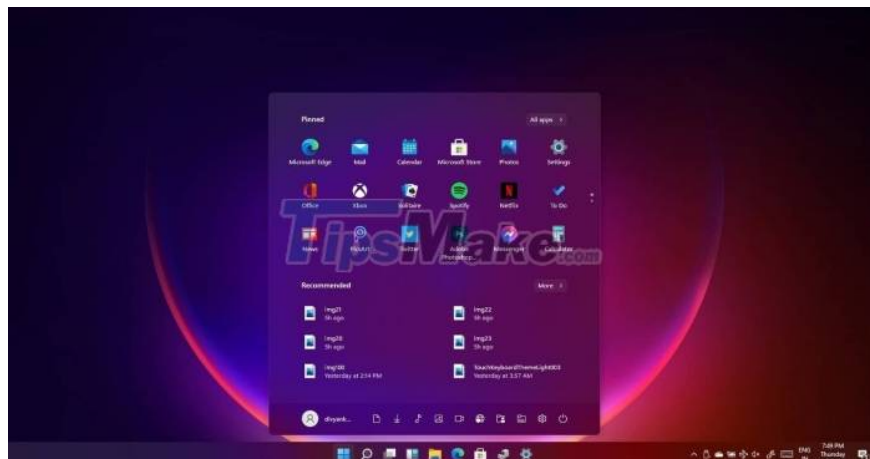
Older PCs running Windows 11 will be faster thanks to the Sun Valley 2 update

A major update of Windows 11 called Sun Valley 2 is expected to be released in the second half of next year. Sun Valley 2 will focus on supporting Android apps, third-party Widgets and a better Windows 11 interface.

Sources confirm that the new version of Microsoft will be released in May 2022.

In the recently released update of Build 2256 for developers, Windows 11 improves the sound quality when connecting to AirPods, the keyboard shortcut ALT + TAB will display as a window, the Searching for files on File Explorer is also easier. Build 2256 will also be integrated on the upcoming Sun Valley 2 version.
