This may be the most serious data scandal since the 2013 Yahoo data breach, which also saw 3 billion users' personal information leaked.

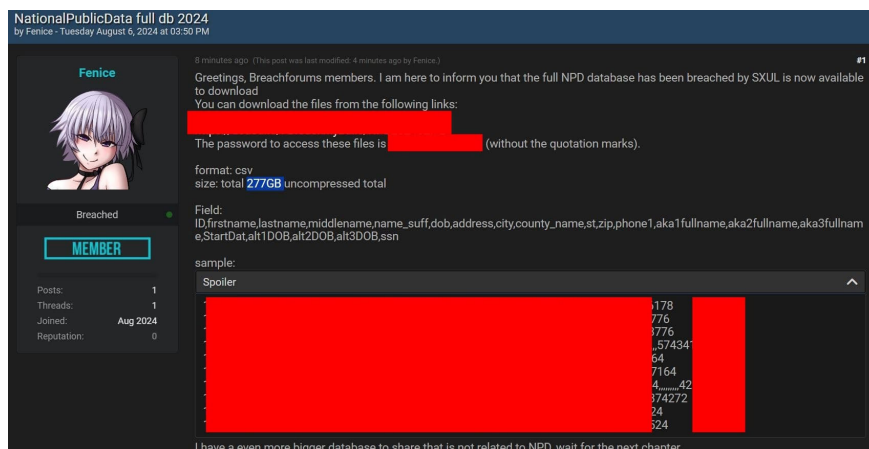

This cyber attack was carried out by a hacker group called USDoD. The entire personal data warehouse of nearly 3 billion people was sold by this group for 3.5 million dollars on dark web databases.



The concern is that those affected may not be aware that their data has been exposed. This sensitive information can be abused by cybercriminals to commit identity theft, open fraudulent credit accounts, borrow money or file fake tax returns, and face trouble. Prolonged legal trouble.
