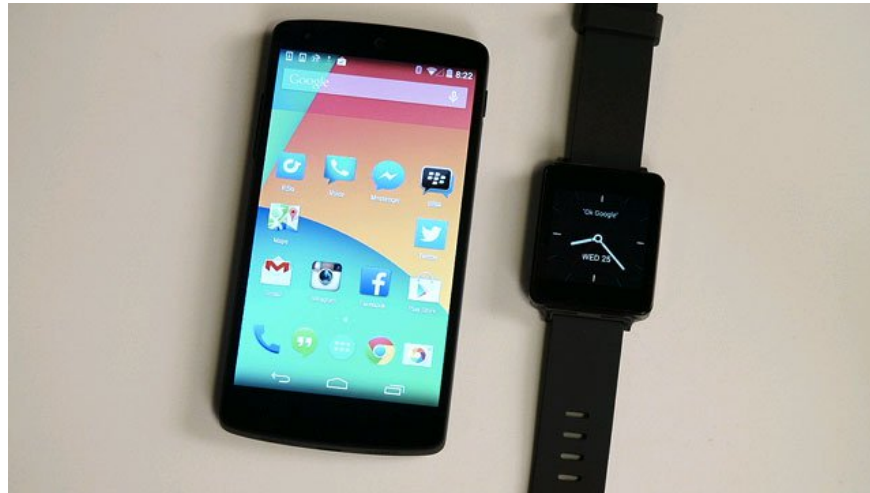


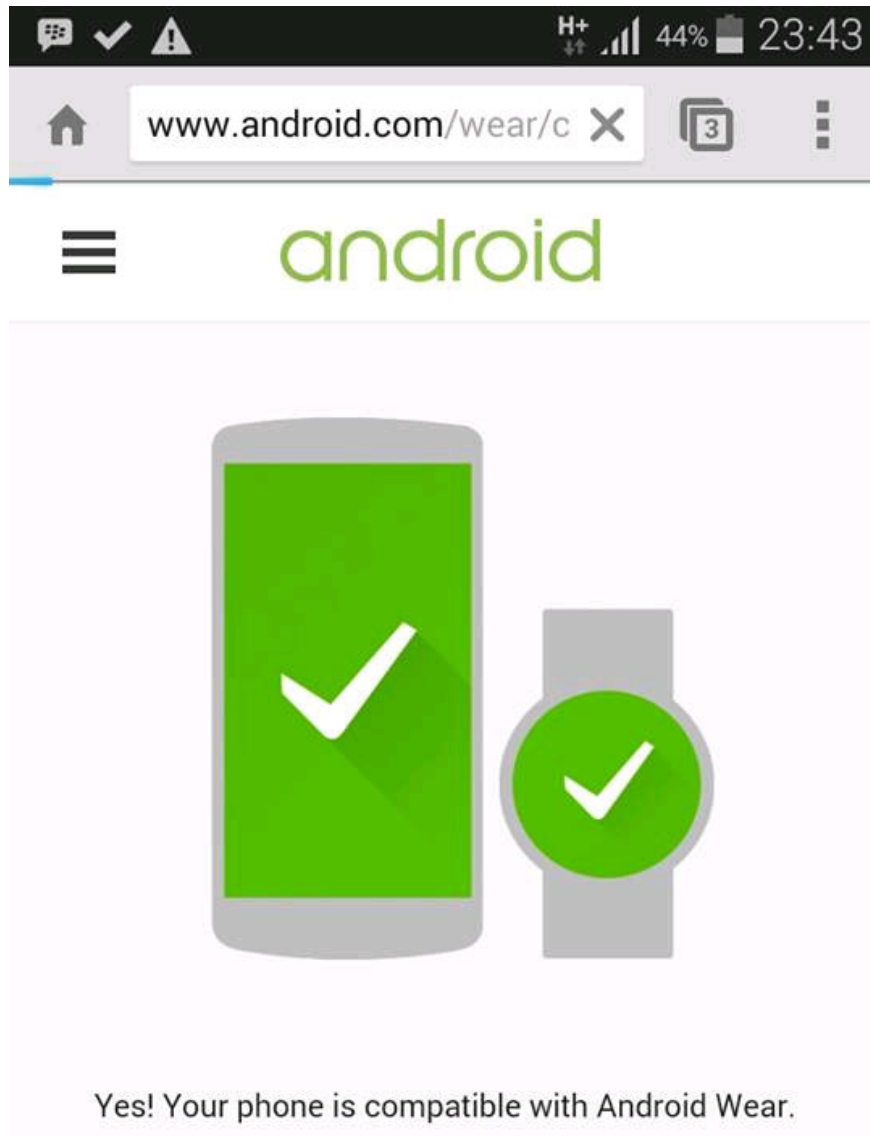
Only 1/4 of devices running Android support Android Wear

According to statistics, only 23.9% of Android devices support Android 4.3 and Android 4.4. This requirement has eliminated more than three-quarters of Android phones in the market that can connect with smart watches running Android Wear.
