

# Open all file formats with a single software

In the process of using a computer, you probably won't be embarrassed at all if you encounter a strange file format and don't know which software to open.

**In the process of using a computer, you probably won't be embarrassed at all if you encounter a strange file format and don't know which software to open. The following article will help you solve this problem completely.**

What do you do if you receive a docx file (Office 2007) while the Office 2003 toolkit is only installed? Or what do you do if you download a file from the Internet, but in a completely strange format without knowing what software to use to open the file?

Typically, each type of file format will have to use a variety of specialized software to open and view the content inside. In particular, for media file formats, users need to install additional codecs to decode and view them.

Finding the right software for file formats is not a simple thing. In addition, installing too many different software to view different file formats is very inconvenient.

With the free tools below, what you need is to install a single software, to see most of the file formats you encounter without installing any additional toolset.

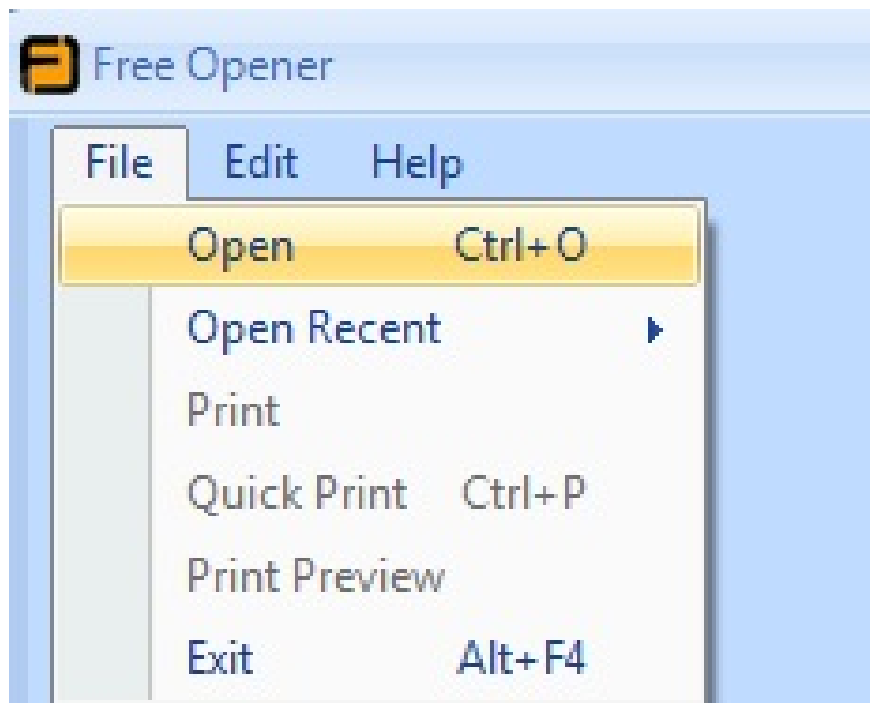
**Free Opener** is a free software that allows users to easily view almost all current file formats, from familiar file formats to strange file formats that you may never know, from Text file format (doc, pdf .) to video files (avi, flv .), music files (mp3, wma .) .

With Free Opener, users will no longer have to install too many different software to open the file simultaneously, as well as no need to spend time searching for software to open the file when encountering strange file formats.

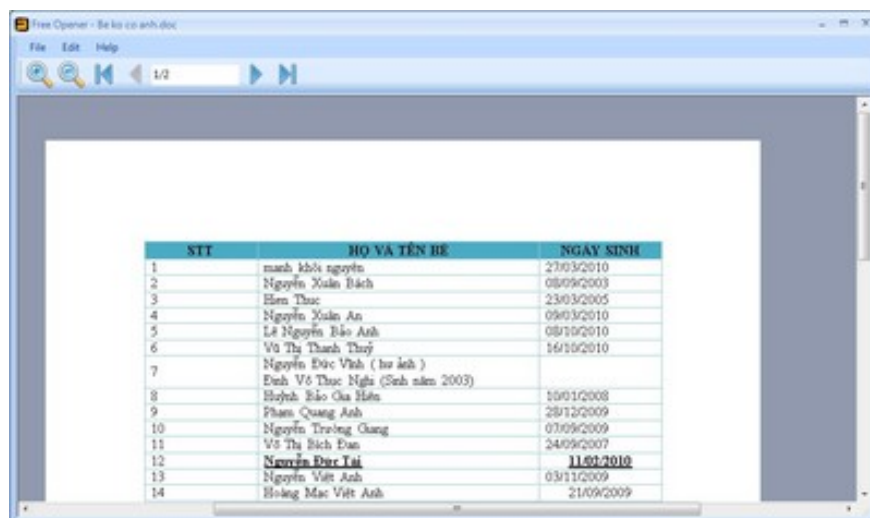
Download the software **here** .

After downloading, proceed with the installation. By default, the software will automatically install a few additional codecs needed to open the file.

Using the software is fairly simple. From the main interface of Free Opener, select **File -> Open** , navigate to the location of the file to open.



The content of the file will be displayed in the interface of the software.



Users can use the key to zoom in / out or switch pages to view the contents of the file.

Free Opener supports more than 75 different file formats, including compressed file formats, media files, images, text .

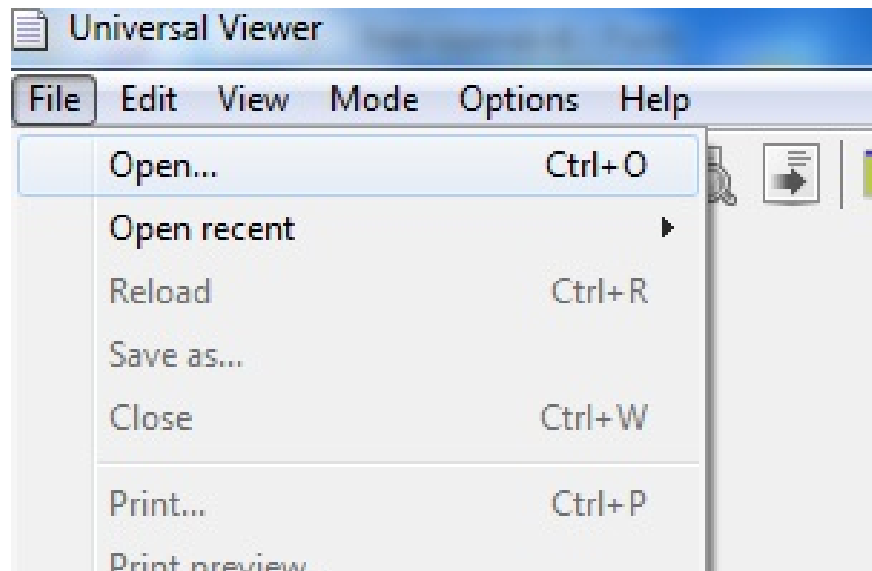
In addition, users can print the contents of files directly from Free Opener by clicking **File -> Print** .

**Note:** Free Opener is the right file viewer software, so this software only works to view the contents of the file, without correcting it.

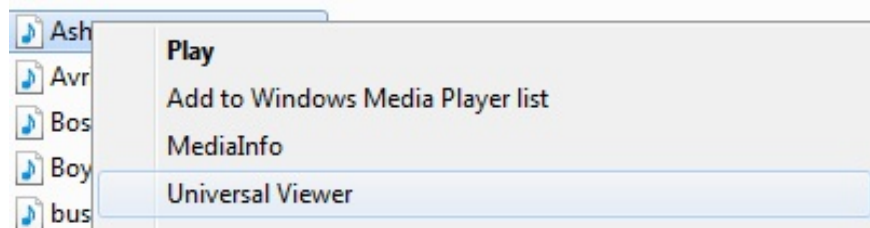
**Universal Viewer** is another tool that allows users to open various file formats, including strange file formats.

Download the free software **here** .

After downloading and installing, how to use similar software Free Opener. From the main interface, select **File** -> **Open** and navigate to the file you need to open.



Unlike Free Opener, Universal Viewer is integrated into the Windows right-click menu, whereby users can right-click on any file, select Universal Viewer to view the contents of the file with the software.



Especially, not only is the file opening software, Universal Viewer also allows users to edit the content of the file, especially with the text file.

To save the contents of the file after editing (if available), click **File** -> **Save as** or click the Save as icon on the software menu.

Basically, Free Opener and Universal Viewer support a number of different file formats, so you should use both software to support each other, in case one of the two software 'bundles' first Some strange file format.
