

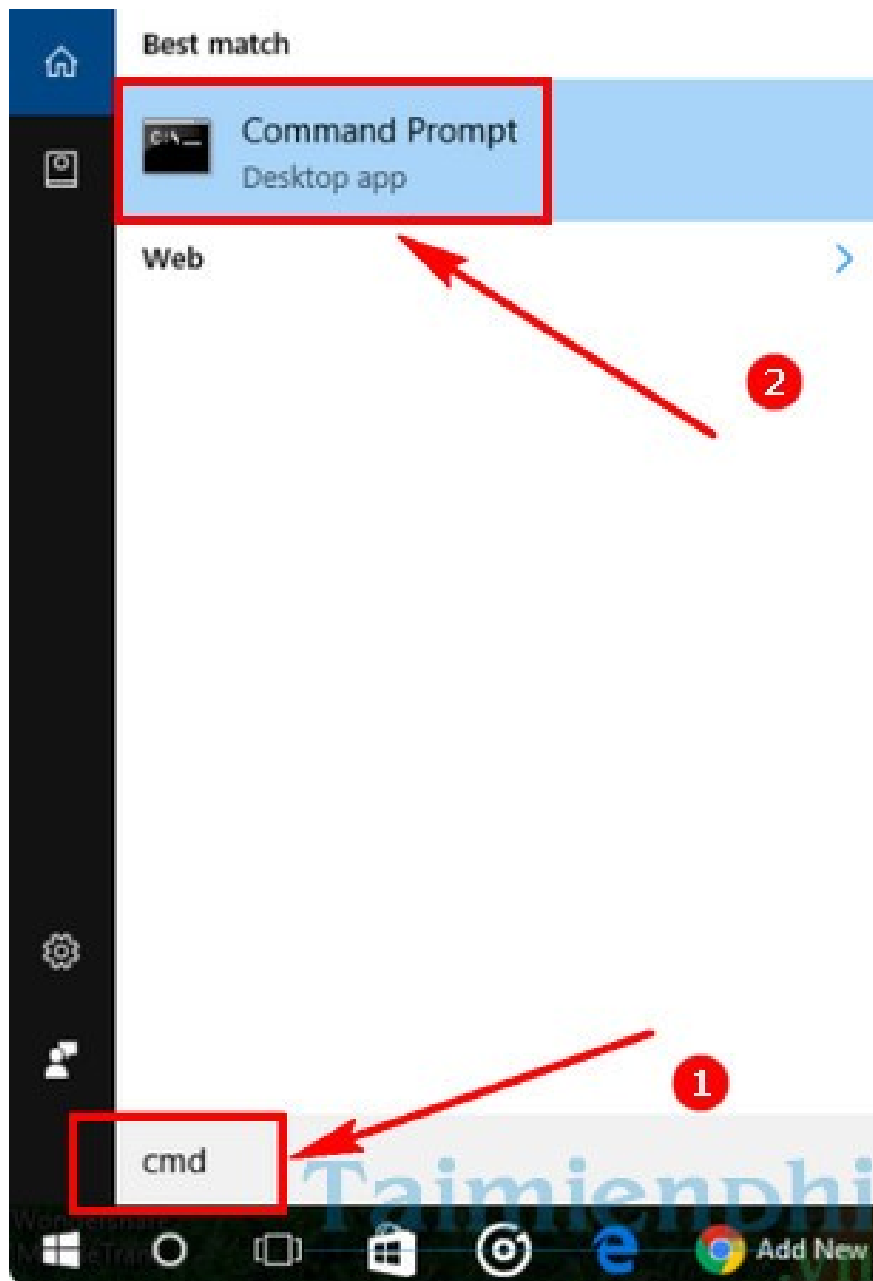
Open Command Prompt with the default small size on Windows 10.

Opening Command Prompt, or CMD, is a tool used to execute commands on Windows. Users are usually familiar with the default size of Command Prompt and CMD. To open CMD in its default small size on Windows 10 or to maximize it, you need to perform the following steps.

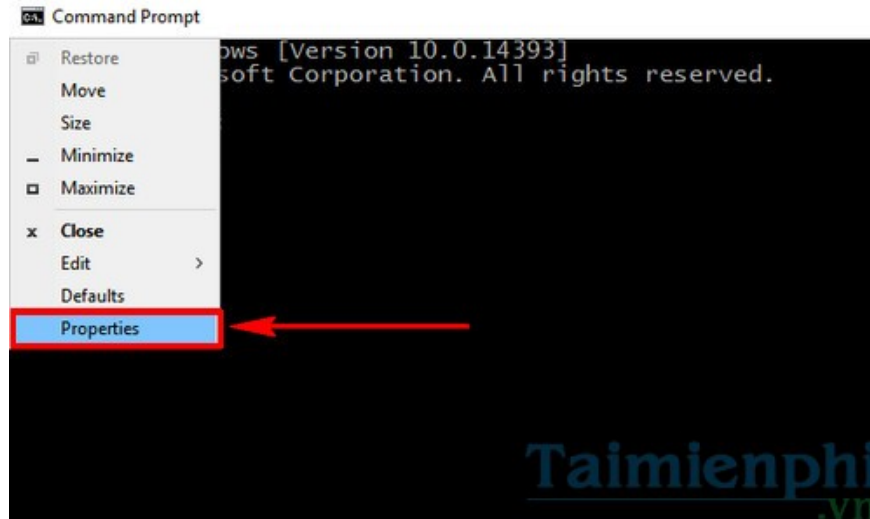
Normally, when using **Command Prompt (CMD)** to enter commands to fix Windows errors, you tend to type the commands directly. However, with commands that are difficult to remember or have many characters, it can be quite challenging to enter them correctly. Therefore, TipsMake has provided a small trick: copying and pasting commands in CMD to save you time. Actually, not many CMD users know how to copy and paste commands in CMD, so read on if you haven't done it before. Additionally, on Windows 10 and other Windows versions, you can change the default size of CMD. Details will be in the following article on opening Command Prompt with a small default size on Windows 10.

Open Command Prompt with the default small size on Windows 10:

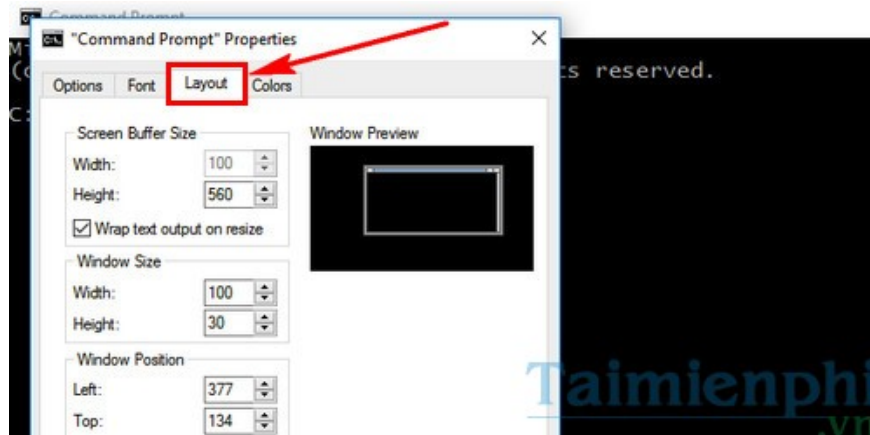
Step 1 : Press **Start** or **the Windows key**. Type **cmd** in the search bar and click on **Command Prompt** in the search results. This method works not only on Windows 10 but also on other Windows versions.



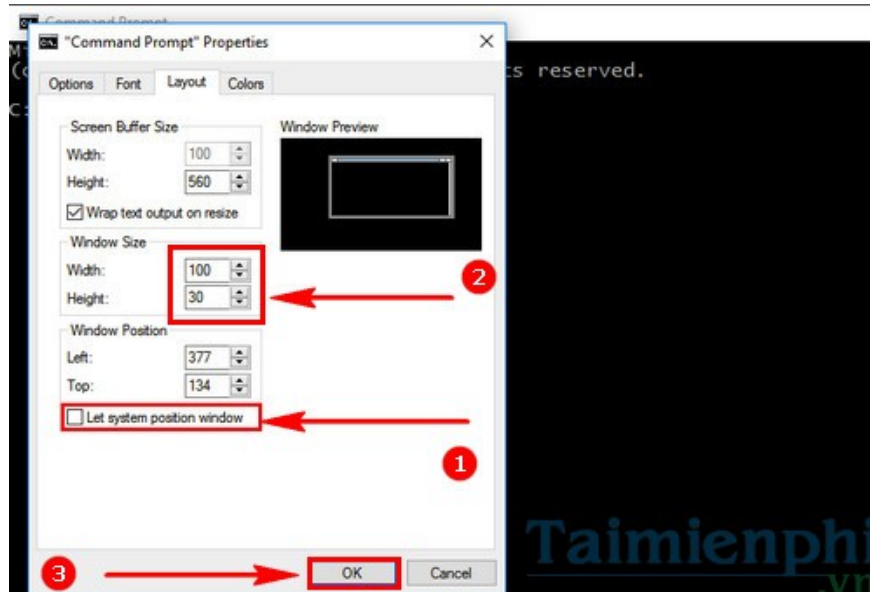
Step 2 : The Command Prompt dialog box will appear. Hover your mouse over the Command Prompt border at the top. **Right-click** on it and select Properties.



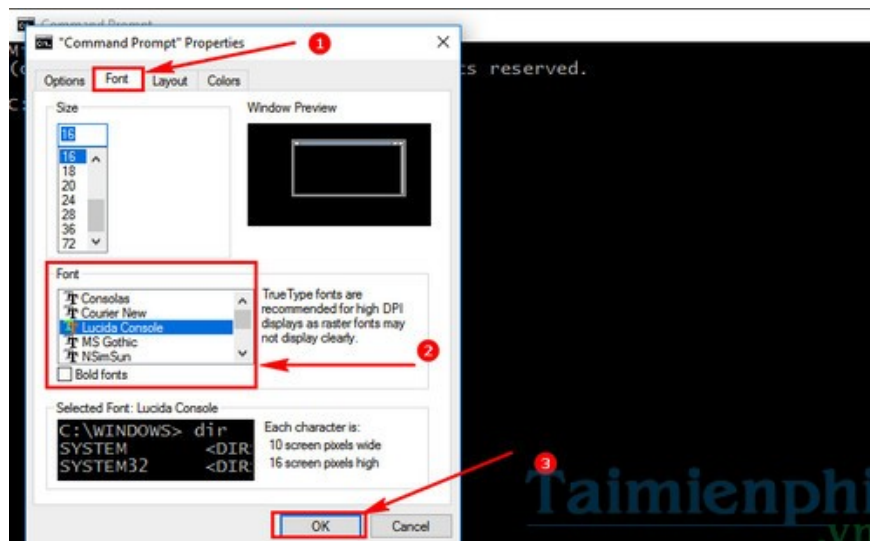
Step 3 : In the "Command Prompt" dialog box , select **Properties** . Click the **Layout** tab. This tab allows you to customize parameters such as the size and default **position of the command prompt on the screen**.



Step 4 : Please **uncheck the box** next to "**Let system position window**". Pay attention to the "**Windows Size**" section ; here, enter the desired length and width of the CMD window. Finally, click **OK** to save the selected size.



Besides changing the CMD size, you can also change the CMD font as you wish. Go to the **Font** tab , select the font size in the **Size** section . Then select **Font** to find the font style you like. Press **OK** to save.



The above trick has helped you change the size of the CMD dialog box, allowing you to minimize and maximize the default size of the Command Prompt. This trick also includes tabs that allow users to change the color in CMD; you can try searching for and using them.

CMD is most commonly used by users when the internet connection is unstable, to check network ping. However, besides that simple trick, there are 15 other popular CMD commands you should know when using Windows. Among these 15 Command Prompt commands , many help you effectively edit and configure Windows settings, such as shutting down your computer. Some other commands are more advanced and are often used by programmers.

In some cases, many users encounter errors preventing them from running CMD commands. This error prevents you from performing operations in Command Prompt. To fix the CMD command failure, you need to follow the instructions provided by TipsMake. Hopefully, these small tips, such as fixing the CMD command failure or

changing the CMD size, will help you use this tool best and easiest on Windows.
