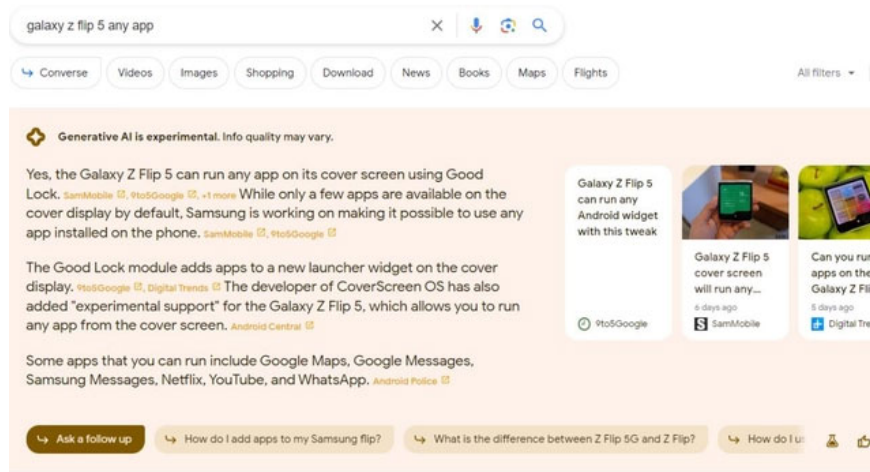
Finally, what Google feared has come true, when OpenAI directly attacked the field that the technology giant dominates - web search.
