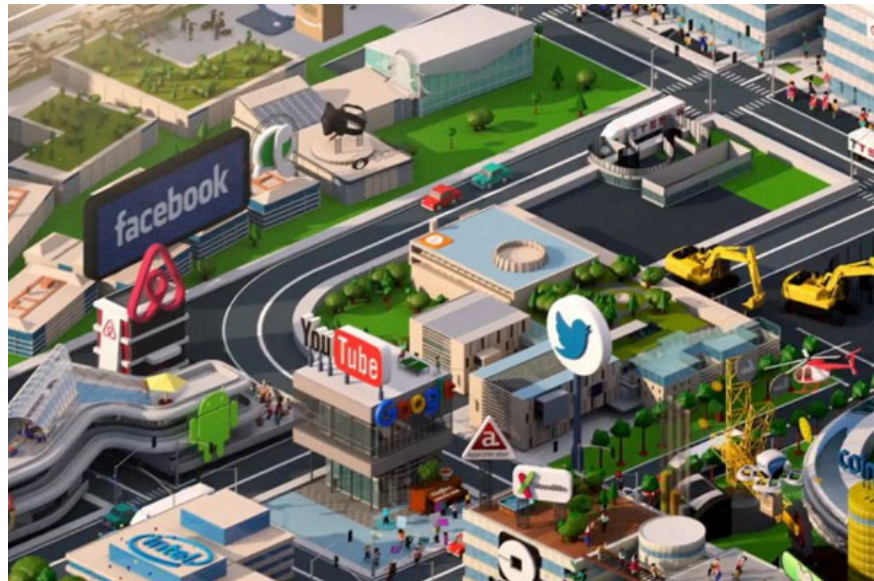
The house has two bedrooms, one bathroom in Silicon Valley costs up to \$ 2.3 million.
