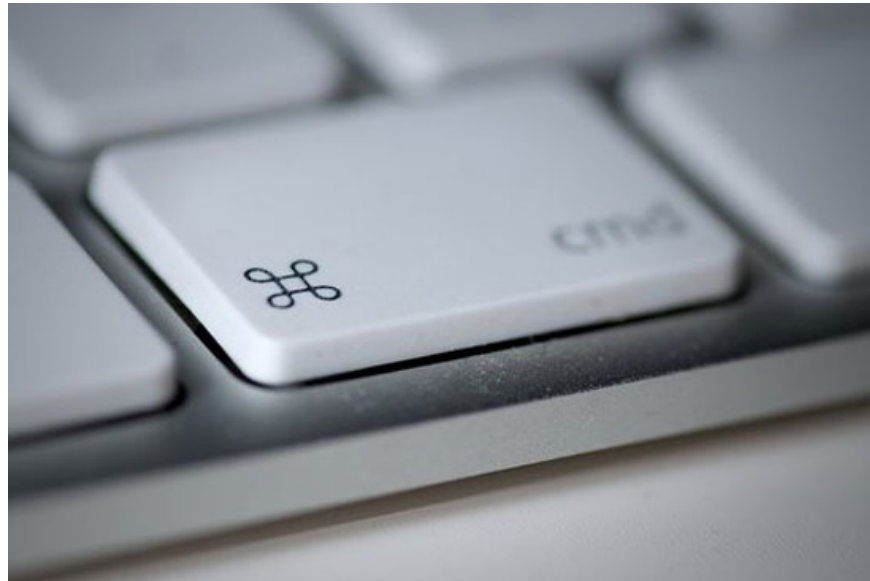


Origin icons on Apple products

Command is one of the most familiar keys for Apple computer users. However, few people know that this is the symbol of Sweden's direction, referring to the place that is a tourist attraction.



According to *Business Insider*, in 1983 due to being too bored with the "Apple" logo used too much on Apple devices, Steve Jobs needed a replacement. Susan Kare, a bitmap designer who searched for a series of icons in the world discovered that the pattern only leads to an ancient Scandinavian ruins area and has chosen this logo.



The Enter key on Windows computers is called **Return** on Mac, which is also a question many users have mentioned.



The Return button inspired by the typewriter on the typewriter, English is " *Carriage Return* ". When you want to start writing a new line on a typewriter, users must drag this lever, similar to the operations of the Return key on the computer.



Icons like playing music, rewinding and fast-forward on the current music player are "*learned*" from the function keys on the tape recorder before.

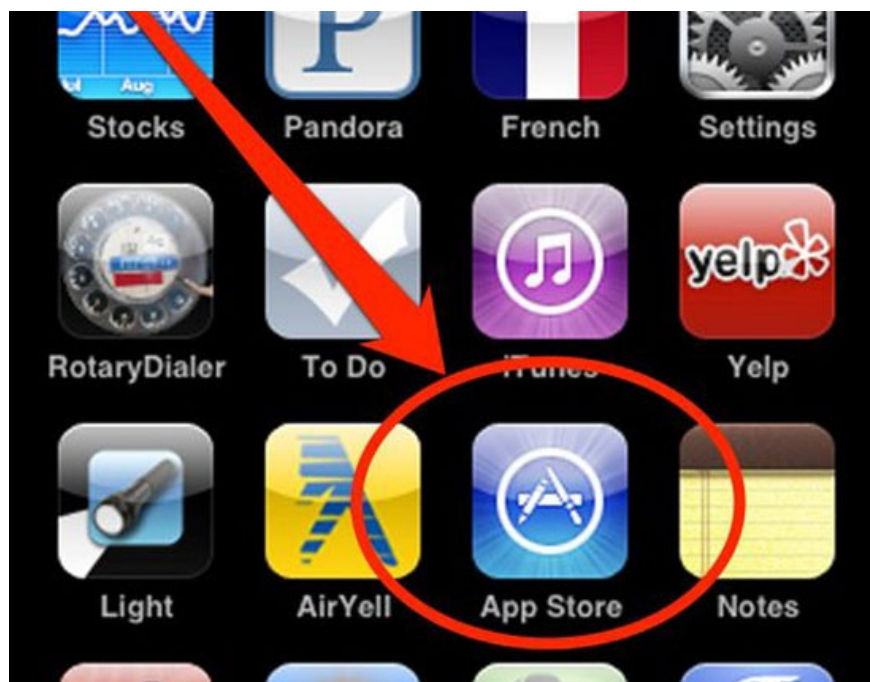
Siri icon on iOS has the same design as the old microphone models from the early 20th century.
