Like the way Yahoo works with its mail service users, Microsoft recently added a policy to delete Outlook accounts if the user does not log in for a predetermined time.

Like the way Yahoo works with its mail service users, Microsoft recently added a policy to delete Outlook accounts if the user does not log in for a predetermined time.



This account deletion policy has been added by Microsoft to the "Service Agreement" section of Outlook. Accordingly, Microsoft requires users within **270 days** to log into their account at least once. Otherwise, the account will be canceled and the data will also be deleted.

In addition, **360-day** deleted accounts will allow any new user to re-register. This information is not mentioned in the Service Agreement, but it is broadcast on some Microsoft forums.
