

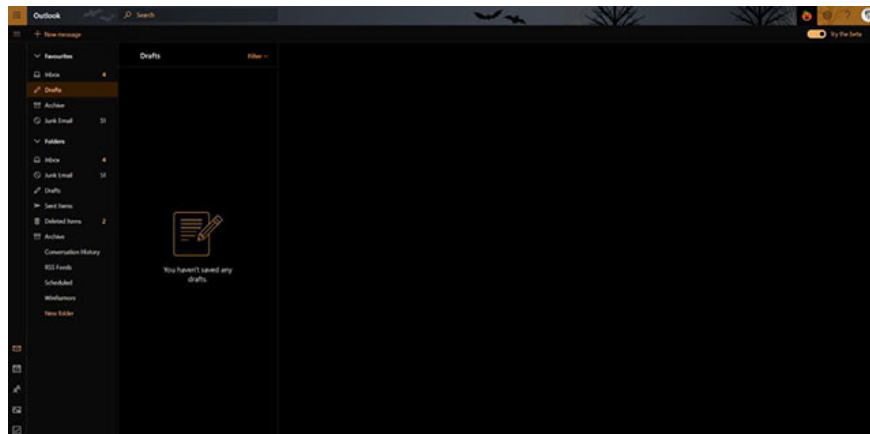
# Outlook.com's night mode is coming soon

Microsoft is planning to launch Dark Mode for Outlook.com web mail service. Although it introduced this mode briefly during last year's Halloween season, Microsoft is still developing this mode in the past few months and has started to "advertise" that the night mode will soon be released.

'One reason we postpone launching is that we want to bring the best Dark Mode on email client services (when you see it you will understand, I guarantee),' the Outlook.com team said. 'What you saw during last year's Halloween season was just a prototype and you had to work hard to get ready for the "golden hour."'

Microsoft said it redesigned color and code 'many times' and it was all in the outline of introducing a new Outlook.com theme.

According to user feedback on the Outlook site, Outlook.com's night mode is one of the most requested features on Microsoft's email web service.

Microsoft first introduced Outlook.com nearly 6 years ago, replacing the old Hotmail service, currently Outlook has about 400 million active users.

Microsoft often updates new features for its web mail service and new designs were also released in March.
