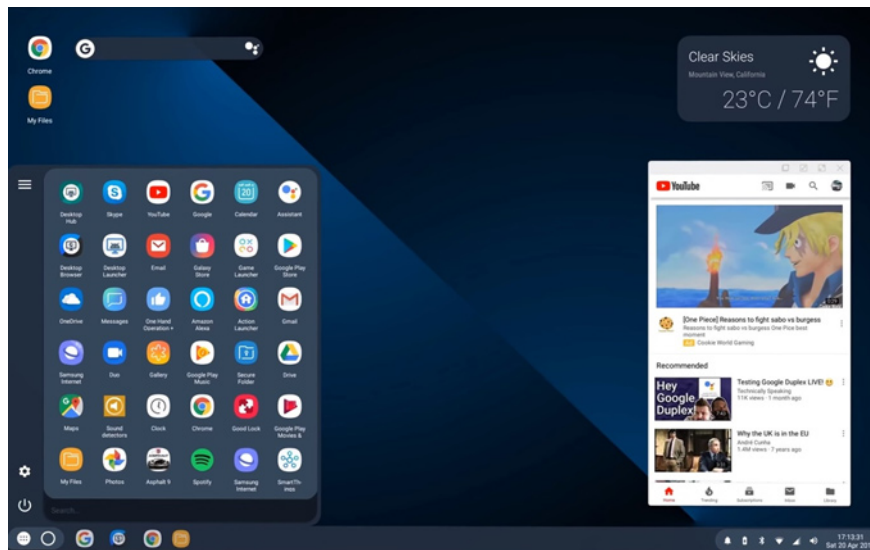

We can see the interface displayed on the removable screen has many similarities with some Android operating systems for PC, the features are also fully supported.

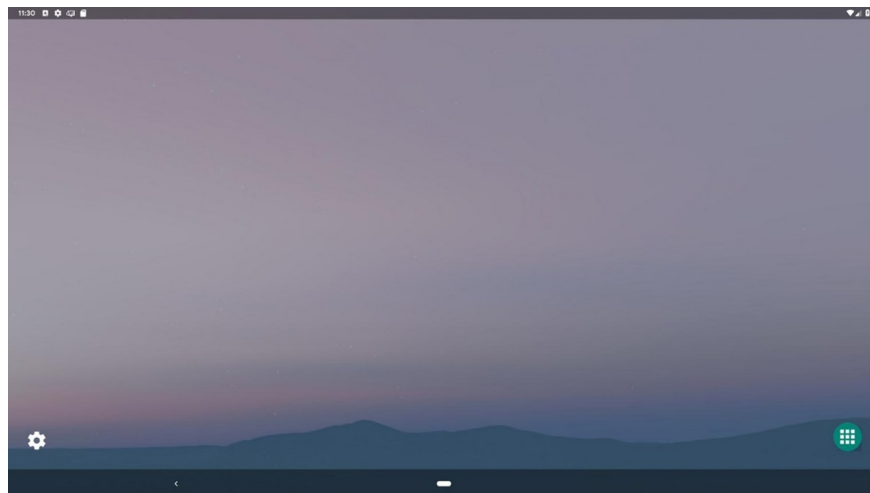

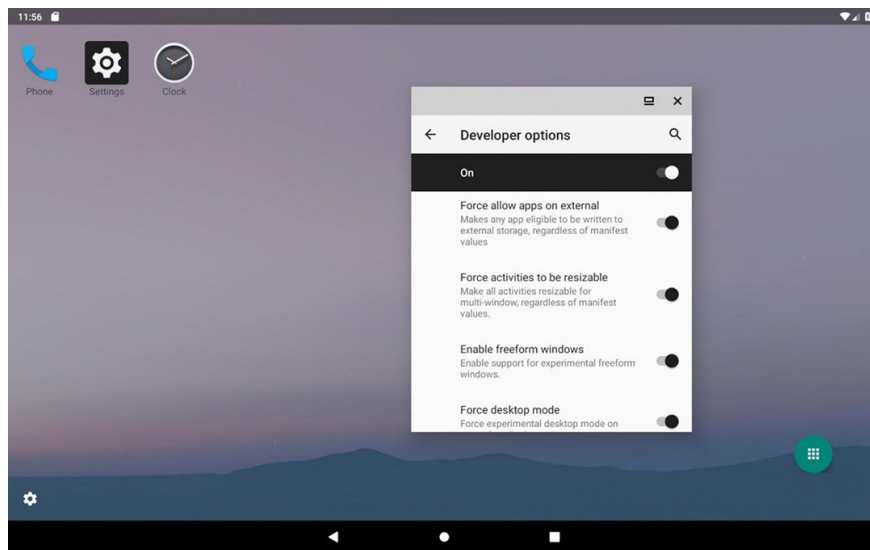
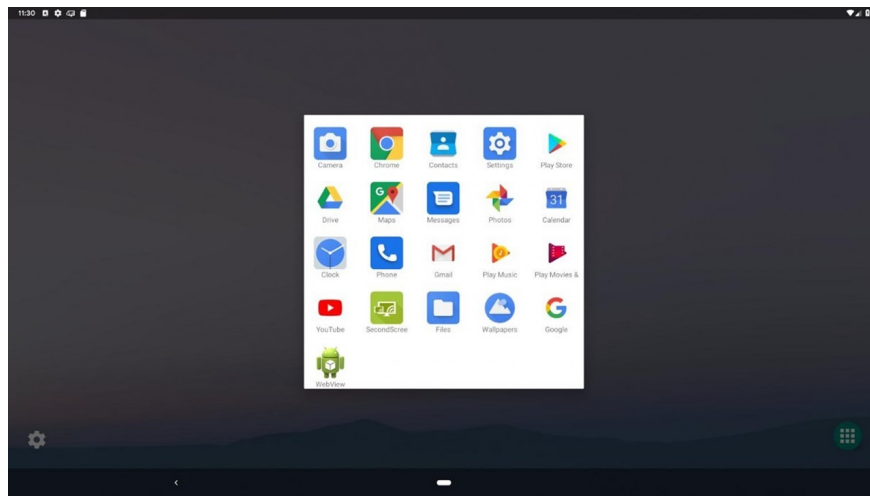
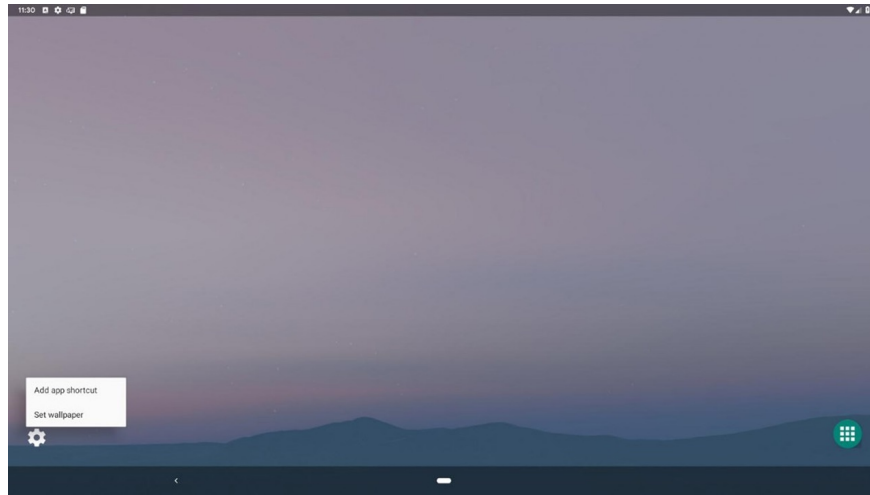
To create shortcuts on the screen, simply drag and drop the app from the tray.
