

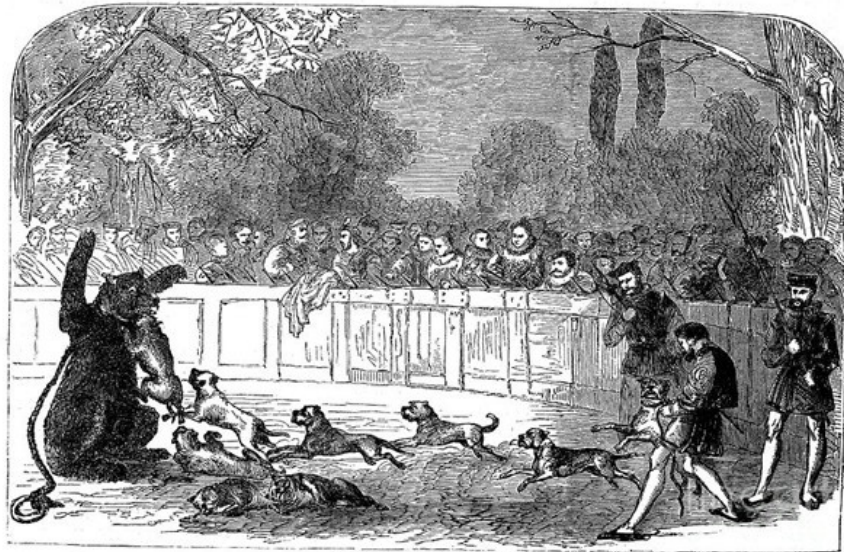
Pleasures cannot be more 'horror' than that of the ancients

In this bear garden, they released the predatory dogs to attack a ferocious bear that was chained to the middle of the field.
