The plot of Dying Light: The Following will continue the story that follows as an additional DLC storyline, also known as the final ending.

Some time has passed since the Dying Light events in the main part. Kyle and his friends continue to fight through the day while the research progress of Dr. Camden's antidote is quite slow. In the middle of worrying about the lack of Antizin, their group saves a strange man. This person had 1 eye blown and was seriously injured and was rescued to death.



Kyle's group found on his brother a map of a road that could be a way out of the city of Harran. Before he died, this guy tried to say something about 'The Mother' but at this time no one understood what it meant. But the next thing he said caught everyone's attention, that is where he lived, there were people who were immune to the Harran virus, they didn't turn into zombies even after being bitten. Kyle decided to follow this map to find his way out to find information about this immune remedy or at least add Antizin to his team.

He traced the map along the sewers and finally found his way to a rural area on the edge of the city. Because of the distance, his radio with Lena and his friends in the city was weak, and now Kyle can only act alone and restrict home contact. There are still harassing zombies here and the survivors seem to be clustering on farms to live. Kyle went to a nearby farm but strangely everyone seemed to alienate him, when he asked to meet the commander, he was introduced to Jasir, the village chief. However, he seemed to be arguing with his daughter and she was furious to leave, and with such a mood Kyle could not hope to know anything except the invitation to eat bread with good pursuits.



Outside, Kyle met a bully-stray merchant named Kaan who also seemed not to be here. Through talking with Kaan, they realized that the one-eyed guy was the one whom Kaan sent to work but unfortunately he lost his life. Kaan needs his help to do the work for him, of course it is not easy because his job is to go around the danger zone to collect leftover items to sell. Kaan asks Kyle to do the job of the man who has just died in exchange for guiding Kyle how to approach the villagers.

When Kyle finished returning, Kaan disappeared, replaced by the daughter of Mr. Jasir earlier, introduced herself as Ezgi and said that the villagers had 'invited' him out of here. She thinks that Kyle is the same type as Kaan, who came here just to make a living. When Kyle asked how she believed that he had come in good faith, she said to find a way to help this village, proving that he came to contribute rather than taking something from them. Ezgi wants Kyle to promise her that she will suggest to him how to help the villagers believe him but in return he will have to help her when needed.

Ezgi said the villagers were having problems with the water supply, but the water plant was located in the area controlled by bandits, and nobody went there. So if you have the strength to follow the pipes to the water plant to lower the bandits and clear the clean water for the villagers, it will be a great success.

Kyle immediately set out and quickly met the bandits at the waterworks. We are offering to sell you clean water at an exorbitant price. Of course, exorbitant sales that do not give a price to threaten people can not end well. He cleaned out the bandits, rescued a man named Ali, he was one of the three people in the village who used to come here and was captured by bandits, the other two died. Ali is a technician, so he instructs Kyle how to open valves to bring water to the villagers.

Returning to the village, Jasir changed his attitude to Kyle, admitting that he might have misjudged him. With a question about the cure, Jasir revealed that they did not need a cure but only prayed towards 'The Mother'. This

is a leader of a sect called the Children of the Sun in this area and this person has the ability to help cult people to be immune to the Harran virus. However, The Mother did not interact with outsiders, but spoke only to his high-ranking priests called Faceless. Kyle wants the Faceless's attention, he has to help the village community continue to grow and when his reputation is high enough, he will have the opportunity to be noticed.

From here Kyle continued to help the villagers and get acquainted with a mechanic, Bilal, who asked Kyle to bring electrical equipment to a transformer station on a nearby hydroelectric dam to help Ali restore the village's electricity. There he meets Ali protected by a masked man and it is strange that the surrounding zombies do not approach these two. Ali said it is one of the Faceless and this person is doing magic to help Ali and Kyle from being attacked by zombies.

The substation was broken, so Ali had to ask Kyle to go deep inside the dam where the electrical control to open the safety switches. During this time, Faceless said that they had expired their spells, so this person led Ali into a hidden place to hide while he stood outside alone and seemed to have died. Kyle returned to protect Ali to finish the last steps to restore power to Jasir's ranch.

Upon returning, Kyle realized that a Faceless was with Jasir, who complimented his credit and invited him to join the cult. Currently, Kyle is not reputable enough to meet The Mother, but Faceless says that if he continues to help people, he will have the privilege of meeting The Mother. This person also gave Kyle a new weapon as a crossbow to help him have more firepower for his missions.



After many credits to help the people, a disciple contacted Kyle and invited him to the island called Eye of the Sun on a lake. In the temple there is a ceremony held, above the stone pedestal is a swarm of zombies. Kaan was also in the audience group with an extremely respectful appearance as if he had just found the truth of life. The Faceless holding incense burners went to the people below, and The Mother also appeared in a red long dress and a yellow mask. Kyle was pulled by Faceless on the pedestal stand with the Zombie but strangely they did not attack him, and Mother spoke to him in her head, telling him to believe her as she believed him.

The ceremony ended and the contact person warned that the effect of immunity would last several hours but Kyle should not try to storm the zombies. His immunity will continue for as long as he continues to help people and have faith in the sect. Returning to Jasir, he handed Kyle a military security card and told a former army employee to die, his belongings were shared among the people and Kyle kept the card for it. There will be some meaning. Jasir also said that the last rite officially recognized him as a member of the Children of the Sun sect

and so he also officially became a member of the village.

In the village, Kyle also found some more information about this strange cult. Specifically, this sect has grown locally but a political incident 50 years ago made small sects banned from circulation. Children of the Sun also retreat into secret operations, only those who truly believe are allowed to join and practice. But since the Harran virus pandemic, the cult has grown back.

On the way to the mission, Kyle also discovered that the remnants of the Rais gang have also found their way here and have a big plot. They constantly plunder and attack residential areas and structures.

Jasir asked Kyle to help him, but this time instead of being serious, his voice was filled with pleading. It was Ezgi, the conflict between her father and son about her love story reached its climax and she ran away from home. Jasir asks Kyle to help bring Ezgi home.

Kyle found Ezgi besieged in a zombie-filled camp, next to her was another girl, who seemed to be a gay couple. Ezgi and her friend wanted to leave this place and go to Harran City to find a more peaceful life because they could not stand the advice of those around them. Although Kyle tried to discourage him, Ezgi did not listen and she repeated her promise of help at first. Kyle has only one way to learn about the way the two girls are going, that is, through a section of an old tunnel that has collapsed, to enter the city and he goes ahead to make way for the couple's safety.



After clearing the volatile drive in the bunker, he informed Ezgi to take his girlfriend on the road and he returned trying to postpone soldiers with Jasir about this. However, only a short time, Ezgi suddenly called for help and Kyle had to return to the tunnel to relieve the siege. It turned out that Ezgi's friend was bitten and when she was walking in the tunnel she turned into a zombie to attack Ezgi. Kyle advises the girl to go home again, but she insists on going, Kyle instructs her to go to the other side and contacts Troy's group to pick the girl on the other end for safety.

Kyle again received a quest from Faceless about a strange phenomenon in the field. When he arrived there was a cloud of smoke similar to the ceremony's smoke and the remaining debris of some military equipment but the contents of the barrel were taken away. Faceless after hearing the story that seemed to understand, immediately Kyle returned to meet with Jasir.

Faceless revealed to Kyle a secret, it was the smoke that helped zombies become dull and not attack people, it was called 'elixir'. This is only a temporary protection measure but the sect is working on a sure cure for this zombie epidemic. They needed more of this medicine to delay the zombie's attacks so they wanted Kyle to find more of them with a deal that would give him a share to take back to Harran City or stay with them for a while. ultimate glory.

Kyle followed the clues Faceless provided to find a cave and discovered that the people who took away the barrels were the Rais. He immediately reported it back to Faceless and continued to track them down to get their goods back.

Faceless gave Kyle a new task, which was to find the home of a man named Atilla, who was an important assistant of The Mother in the research of antidote, but they lost contact with him. When he arrived, Atilla's estate was attacked by zombies and lost power, but he was safe. Atilla seemed more depressed than at risk, saying that he had terminal cancer who couldn't go out of archaeological research as before. After Kyle helped clear the zombies from the building and restored electricity, Atilla asked him to look for 3 ancient stone pillars to learn about ancient legends that have clues for curing viruses.

Kyle found a red mask on one of the three ancient stone pillars and brought it back to Atilla. He told Kyle about an ancient prophecy. As the plague spread and darkness enveloped the earth, one would choose to sacrifice himself to call upon the sun god. When the chosen person walks through the death gate, the sun god will bring healing light to everyone. Atilla said goodbye to Kyle and said he needed more time to write a report and contact Faceless later.



However, the next day Faceless reported that Atilla had not contacted, so they asked Kyle to check on Atilla. When he arrived he found a letter Atilla left. He said he was an ethnologist who went to Harran to learn about the region's historical culture and to know the army colonel's husband and wife. The husband is Mr. Amir and the wife is Jasmine, she is also The Mother later. When the outbreak broke out, Mr. Amir became infected with the virus and left Atilla with him before he died. The colonel left Atilla with a piece of code and told him to keep it a secret, if his wife was awake after the outbreak, hand it to her. Unfortunately, Jasmine turns into The Mother and no longer sees Atilla again. He handed this code to Kyle.

In the basement of the house, Kyle discovered a stone pedestal and the body of Atilla. He committed suicide because he believed that sacrificing himself would help solve the virus disaster. However, Faceless explained

that they had known about this prophecy for a long time, but Atilla had misinterpreted the prophecy into suicide. Kyle returned to wearing a mask and Atilla's research notebook.

Faceless informed Kyle of the bandits' new leads, whereby they seemed to be storing the stolen elixir in a large warehouse. Kyle immediately attacked the warehouse and found a captured Faceless, who tortured him by nailing the mask and penetrating his face. This person was concerned that the thieves took the goods but did not know how to use it, they were trying to catch The Mother to try out the medicine. The last clue the Faceless brothers left was the lighthouse.

Breaking into the lighthouse, Kyle discovers that Kaan is the traitor, he provides information about the cult to the Rais and becomes a low-level commander of the bandits. Through the perpetrators' radio and Kaan's testimony, Rais and the others were shown attacking the dam, where The Mother was staying. The bandits below realize that Kyle is capturing Kaan on the lighthouse and firing rockets, causing it to collapse, Kaan falls down dead and Kyle is lucky to fall into the car, so he just gets humid. He tried to recover the remaining drugs but only found a few. Kyle warned of an attack with Faceless just when they were defeated and now he has to run quickly to the dam to help him.



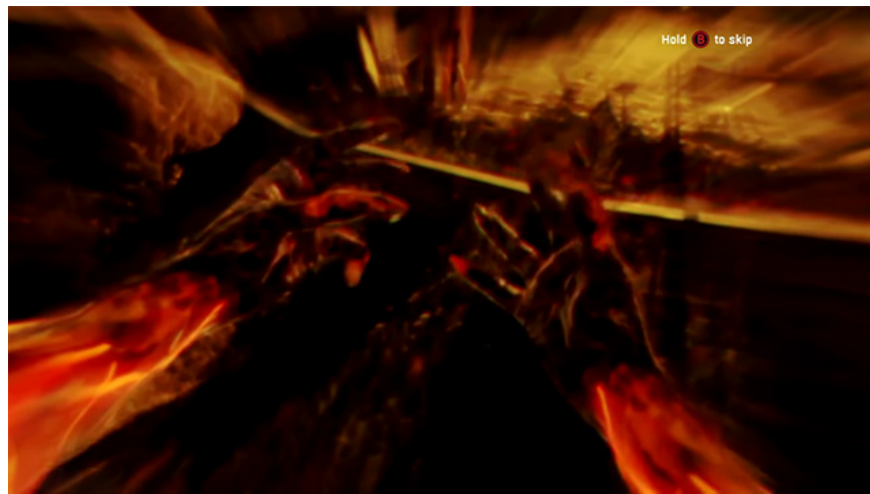
When he reached the dam, both sides were dead, only The Mother's voice resounded in his head. She said that Children of the Sun was just a small religion that was forgotten over time, and that she and her husband, Colonel Amir, were respected by the people in the area while they were here. But when a pandemic struck, two people were attacked by zombies and bitten, her husband died of blood loss and left her his cigarette case. She was saved by members of the cult and they worshiped her as the new leader. Jasmine remembered her husband not smoking so opened the box when it contained a map, keys and codes.

Jasmine follows them to this dam and discovers the fact that her husband is involved in the virus development project and they find a barrel, the code in the cigarette case helps them open the box and inside there is a ampoule. As she was about to turn into a zombie, Jasmine had nothing to lose, so she drank the medicine hoping that her husband would lead her to the right antidote. It is true that the antidote, she survived but gradually turned into high volatile, an extremely advanced zombie and has the ability to communicate telepathically in the minds of others without opening her mouth. During the day she retains her spirit but at night the volatile nature of her rise turns into a champion monster that can kill any creature in sight.

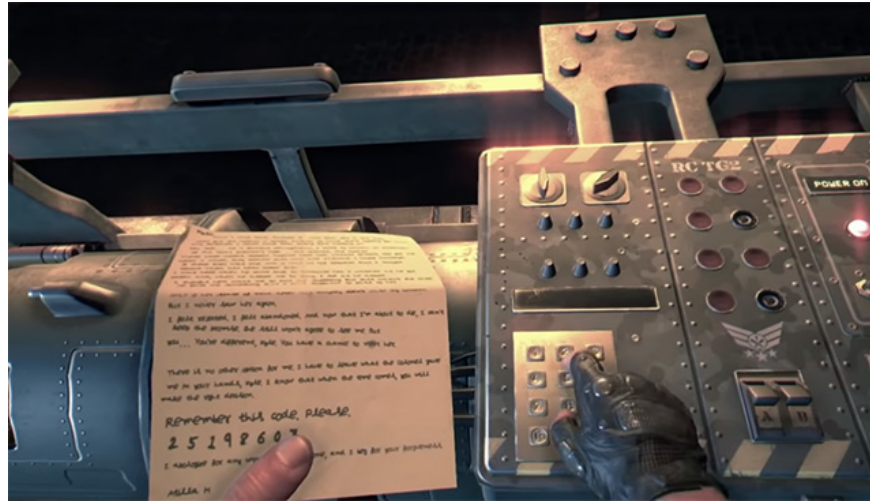
Kyle now appears full of signs of the prophecy of the chosen. Mother says he will be the one who chooses the future for humanity. The Mother acknowledged that there was no antidote because the drug they were on only slowed down the development of the virus, but if used more would gradually turn into volatile. And Kyle has also inhaled this drug so his turn into volatile is only a matter of time although inhalation will be slower than drinking directly as in the case of The Mother.

Now the only way to save humanity is to destroy the whole area of ??Harran. The military had prepared for the worst from the beginning and they placed a nuclear bomb in this dam. By sacrificing the entire population of the Harran region they will be able to quell the spread of the virus. This corresponds to the prophecy that the chosen one will sacrifice (tens of thousands of lives) and walk through the death gate (activating a nuclear bomb by hand) in exchange for the cleansing and healing light (the light when the bomb explodes). destroy virus germ).

At this point, the end of the Dying Light: The Following storyline will depend on the player's choice.



If Kyle refuses the offer, The Mother will force him to take a vial and attack him. Kyle kills The Mother, but the drug has infiltrated him, causing him to hallucinate. Kyle emerged from a sewer and realized he was in a playground with children there. He seems to have found a way out of the quarantine area of ??Harran city to escape outside because the life here is as smooth as never before. The children who saw him suddenly screaming and running to their mothers' side, realized that his hands had turned into volatile arms ever since and when the sun was out, he dashed like an animal.



If Kyle agrees with the plan, The Mother will lead him into the room where the nuclear bomb is located, and she confesses that he is the chosen one because she only has the key to unlock the door and the bomb activation code, her husband. do not give. Kyle suddenly remembered the code that Atilla left, that was Amir's preparation in case Jasmine was crazy enough not to be alert enough, so he needed someone else to keep the activation code to compare with his wife. I avoid her taking risks. Kyle entered the code and turned on the trigger, for a brief 10 second count he looked into Jasmine's monster face and heard a brief thank you before everything went blank.

The plot of Dying Light: The Following ends with the idea that if one sacrifices to sacrifice a few to protect humanity, everything will still be saved. But if being persistent and selfish when a pandemic breaks out, no one will be able to save anyone. Now we will head to Dying Light 2 to see if the manufacturer of Techland will give any surprises to players!
