Later, it was also the reason that Donovan had to pay the price with his career as a public servant, but there was nothing wrong with helping his friends, he was happy. Back to the matter, Lincoln first wanted to regain the area previously owned by his foster father. Unfortunately during the time Sammy was murdered, The Black Mob group was also in disarray, so Delray Hollow is now in a tug of war between the forces in the region.



In fact, Sal Marcano had appointed the Dixie Mafia to take over the area after killing both the Robinson family and setting fire to the bar, but the Haitian group did not comply with that, so they fought back fiercely. Now they were temporarily holding off the Dixies, but it was only a matter of time for Sal's disciples to take control of Hollow. If Lincoln wants to get back his father's old place and needs any help, of course, he has to meet the new leader to talk. The veteran felt weird because Baka had been killed by him before, but Donovan said that the

Haitian had a new leader but all his personal information was hidden too carefully. Even an experienced CIA could not find anything useful, so Lincoln's first job was to investigate the new leader of Haiti. From the information he gathered, he knew the new boss was hiding at the shop specializing in the decoration of evil arts so he decided to break into it.

Fate was shaken for Lincoln to meet an old acquaintance when the new 'boss' of the Haitian gang is none other than Cassandra, the girl he once encountered while killing Baka. Cassandra thinks Sammy was too naive to be alive, so she frankly wonders what the benefit she could be if she put in the effort to help Lincoln get revenge? By this time we know that Cassandra and Lincoln share a deep enemy, Ritchie Doucet. The leader of the Dixie Mafia has not only stabbed the young brother's brother Ellis to death, but his bizarre hobby also caused Cassandra's younger sister to die completely. Ritchie had a sickly hobby of abducting black children, locking them up, and starving for a few days.



Plot Mafia III: Return of the veteran and the fall of Sal Marcano - Part 1

Mafia III brings players to the gang battles that will take place in the city of New Bordeaux a perfect version of New Orleans in real life.

He would then untie the children to run away, but the mafia usually carries very fierce hunting dogs with starving days just like the children. Those who are quicker will escape but often the winning dogs and Cassandra's sister are also eaten in such a savage 'relief'. Because the two gangs are still in conflict, Ritchie often changes shelter, but his two loyal brothers, Merle Jackson and Charlie Kincaid, are still running the prostitution line at the old Perla theater and selling ghosts. You can start at hand from this line. After Lincoln killed Merle, captured Charlie and called Cassandra to ban her juniors to occupy the brothel area and loot drug paraphernalia, Ritchie did reveal some moves at Baron Saturday park. Then Sal Marcano's first limb went to penance when Lincoln used the ferris wheel at the amusement park to hang him up.

Former FBI agent Jonathan Maguire in his memoirs wrote about the incident when Lincoln treated Ritchie as follows: 'When I saw Ritchie dangling on a ferris wheel, that image had a profound impact on my psychology.

As a student who has just been recruited by the FBI, I've never seen such a strange scene before. The mafia who can pay each other in the normal way can also give the opponent a shot at the temple while he is still eating the spaghetti dish. But the way Lincoln Clay executes Ritchie Doucet leaves people in awe. ' After destroying Ritchie and gaining complete service of Cassandra, Lincoln now begins to calculate the approach to Thomas Burke. Thomas is the leader of the Irish gangster in New Bordeaux and the father of Danny Burke, The young man went to rob the bank with the veteran who was later handled by the Marcano gang.



Thomas Burke initially ran activities related to theft and fraudulent consumption in Pointe Verdun district for Sal Marcano. But a cargo break in mid-1966 left Sal feeling so upset that he decided to kick Thomas out of the group and hand Pointe Verdun back to Roman 'The Butcher' Barbier. Of course, this transfer of power is not smooth when the mafia with the nickname butcher has used a long slash to break Thomas's leg. Two years later, when listening to the barber Sal Marcano wanted to make the break into the Federal Reserve, Thomas sent Danny to help in the hope that if the successful robbery would resume relations with the Italian-born mafia. But apparently this plan was not very successful. Frustrated by the death of his son but unable to do anything for revenge, The Irish man often went to Duffy Irish Pub to drink until he was drunk.

Nine weeks before Lincoln regained consciousness, Burke became a laughing stock for every wandering man in New Bordeaux as he drank a fishing rod at Duffy Irish Pub and then fired his gun at Barbier to fire 9 shots and no bullets. hit the target. Perhaps Barbier was also tired of the red-haired drinker, so he ordered the juniors to beat him up for a battle and throw them in the landfill behind the pub. Lincoln sympathized with Burke because he understood what it was like to be depressed when losing a loved one but to get revenge he needed to revive a father who was engulfing himself with alcohol to forget the pain of losing his son. Another name that appears on the recruitment priority list is Vito Scaletta (See also **the Mafia II storyline**). After being expelled from Empire Bay for killing Carlo Falcone, Vito moved to work for Sal Marcano and was given the right to manage the River Row. In fact, Sal was never satisfied with the new man because he suspected Vito was an eye and ear dispatched by The Commission.



However, under pressure from Leo Galante, a senior member of The Commission, Sal still had to be reluctant to use Vito. The more time he accumulated, the more Sal felt Vito's eyes but he was in no hurry to move because according to the rules set by The Commission, tycoons could not arbitrarily kill generals under their command if there was no main reason worthy and approved by the committee. The incident lasted until early 1968 when Sal's patience was at the limit, so he decided to find a way to eliminate Vito. The first step is to bring Michael Grecco (his nephew) into the core gang in the River Row District to plot to find the opportunity to oust Vito and then be killed without being punished by The Commission. In the opinion of Donovan, Both Thomas Burke and Vito Scaletta have different problems but they can absolutely become a powerful arm for Lincoln because they share a deep feud with Sal Marcano.

The location of the two mafia hands was given to the veteran by Donovan. Thomas Burke is quite easy to find because he is often drunk at Duffy Irish Pub. Lincoln met him outside the bar, trying to persuade him to team up with him against Sal but only received terrible curses. Burke only submitted and agreed to contribute to Lincoln after witnessing the guy taking control of his car then launching at altar speed on the highway. As for Vito Scaletta, he almost died because of Grecco's assassination. With Lincoln's help, Vito killed Grecco, sabotaged Sal's malicious plan and submitted to the veteran, so he decided to withdraw from the Marcano society to join the forces of Lincoln Clay with Cassandra and Thomas Burke.
