Although the **Resident Evil 3 Remake** plot is cut a lot, it also has a few things to worry about, especially the supporting characters like Carlos are more talked about and likely to reappear in the parts. next, not always as the original.



Plot Resident Evil 3 Remake: Escape from the dead city - Part 1

Basically the Resident Evil 3 Remake story is not much different from the original, but it has been omitted some side details.

## Carlos Oliveira



As a member of the Rapid Reaction Squad - Umbrella Biohazard Countermeasure Service (UBCS), Carlos carries the rank of corporal and takes on the task of using heavy weapons, as well as protecting the team's backline while working. mission. Carlos was a Latin American man, before joining UBCS, Carlos was a soldier in the guerrilla forces in South America, after this rebel group was suppressed by the government, he was Umbrella noticed and joined the UBCS

When the T-Virus disaster broke out in Raccoon City, Carlos along with 120 other soldiers in the Delta rapid-response team were helicoptered to the city, with an initial mission to rescue the remnants. Unlike the original, Resident Evil 3 Remake only briefly describes the fate of Delta team when it appears that they seem to have been betrayed by Nikolai and intentionally led to death. When the Resident 3 Remake plot unfolds, the entire Delta team is only 3 people, Carlos, Nikolai and captain Mikhail.



Later, Carlos learns that his true mission is not to rescue but actually destroy, when the Delta team is dispatched to wipe out all the witnesses left in Raccoon City, to prevent the information from leaking. Virus was leaked out. In the Resident Evil 3 Remake plot we can see Carlos more mature than the old version, as well as more acting space. At the end of the episode when Jill takes the broken Vaccine bottle on the plane with Carlos, she vows to take revenge on Umbrella, due to the high possibility that Carlos will continue to appear rather than disappear mysteriously.

It is interesting to note that Carlos was born in 1977, which is 3 years younger than Jill, so you can consider this to be a plane flight both literally and figuratively.

## Mikhail Viktor



Born in 1953 in Leningrad (now Saint Peterburg), Mikhail was originally a former Soviet military professional with the rank of Captain. After the collapse of the Soviet Union resulted in the removal of a large number of former officers and Mikhail was among them, he gradually joined guerrilla organizations, fought and wandered around. But eventually these organizations began transforming into terrorist groups, so it was later destroyed by the government and Mikhail was accepted by Umbrella. Thanks to his experience and leadership from his time as a professional soldier, he was appointed captain in the UBCS as well as retained his rank of Captain.



In the Resident 3 Evil Remake storyline, Mikhail takes on the task of commanding the Delta team on a mission in Raccoon City, like Carlos, Mikhail does not know the nature of this mission but still thinks it is the rescue of survivors. . Mikhail's Delta team was almost destroyed in the two days after landing on the 26th, the survivors ran to the subway to take shelter temporarily and Mikhail himself was seriously injured.

Mikhail later realized dimly about Nikolai's betrayal as well as why the entire Delta task force was being pushed to the city without being prepared for the information, but by then it was too late. Mikhail's outcome was quite tragic when he was captured by Nemesis while in the same carriage as Jill (this was knocked down when Nemesis would kill anything that stood between it and her prey), Mikhail used explosive charges. left to die together with Nemesis as she sent it flying down the subway tracks.

## Nikolai Zinoviev



Like Mikhail, Nikolai is also a Soviet soldier and a special task force, he has a close relationship with Sergei Vladimir, because of his skills and experience when he was a special agent, Nikolai was Umbrella assigns a variety of missions, including in the UBCS, USS, and even field observers. Nikolai had time to train in USS forces and considered HUNK as his opponent, he had great greed so right during his time working for Umbrella, Nikolai was willing to be a double agent to sell the nest. function.

On September 15, 1998, the UBCS team received a warning about a new mission, when Umbrella noticed signs of people infected with T-Virus in Raccoon City. On September 26, the Delta team left, but Nikolai did not take the helicopter but secretly arrived in the city first to prepare.



He was assigned a number of important tasks, the first being to test the ability of UBCS to fight in an environment surrounded by mutated specimens (Zombie from T-Virus), the second is to wipe out all marks. T-Virus marks include both the sample and Vaccine to prevent it from leaking out, affecting Umbrella. Tuesday Nikolai also had to record the manifestations of the new BOW (Nemesis) in performing a specific task, here is killing the STARS members. Nikolai finally had to find a way to recover the Thanatos Project - a Improved research format from Tyrant T-103 model created by Dr. Greg Mueller.

Nikolai will receive a bonus depending on the task he completes, but due to his insatiable greed, Nikolai has accepted to work as an inner hand for the rival organization of Umbrella (in the Resident 3 Remake storyline is not clear. who is), to sell information to both parties and make money on both ends.



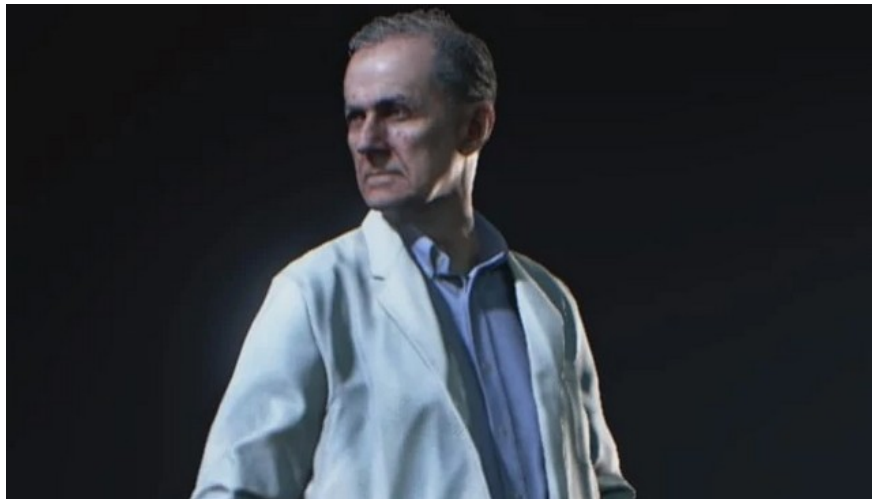
Taking advantage of the information and going to the city first, on September 26 Nikolai deliberately lured a bunch of Cerberus to Raccoon University to kill the survivors hiding there. It was he who also caused the Delta team to be severely damaged, when intentionally closed the doors in the city to make them stuck with the Zombie. On September 28, Nikolai accidentally met Jill and learned that she was the target Nemesis was aiming for, Nikolai then gathered with the Delta team to avoid suspicion.

When Nemesis attacked the ship, Nikolai was the first to run, leaving Jill and Mikhail to stay with the monster. This accident separates Nikolai from the UBCS team so that he can free his hand to the city hospital to assassinate Dr. Nathaniel Bard, destroying the last witness who knew about the T-Virus in the Umbrella research team. Before the nuclear warhead reached the city, Nikolai was able to gather the surviving soldiers of the UBCS to perform the task of recovering Thanatos, unfortunately the blood sample of the Tyrant was later lost, so Umbrella did not can recreate it.



The end for the traitor is always death, even if Nikolai took the Vaccine sample and found his way out of the city before it was destroyed by the nuclear warhead, Jill and Carlos still caught up to punish the cockroach. the message. There is a small detail in the story of Resident 3 Evil Remake that until the very last moment, Nikolai still does not tell who his hire is, maybe this will be a new detail in the later remake games.

## **Nathaniel Bard**



Dr. Nathaniel Bard is a newcomer in the Resident 3 Evil Remake storyline, who was appointed chief researcher after the Spencer Memorial Hospital (Raccoon's main hospital) was built. Bard was talented but arrogant and looked down upon others, when he frequently got into fights with hospital staff.

In addition to the doctor's cover, Bard is also an Umbrella scientist and operates at the NEST 2 research institute located just below the hospital's underground, unlike NEST 1 focusing on virus research (G and T-Virus). ), then Nest 2 focused on creating biological weapons such as Tyrant or Hunter, the Gamma Hunter is also the finished product escaped from the sewer from NEST 2.

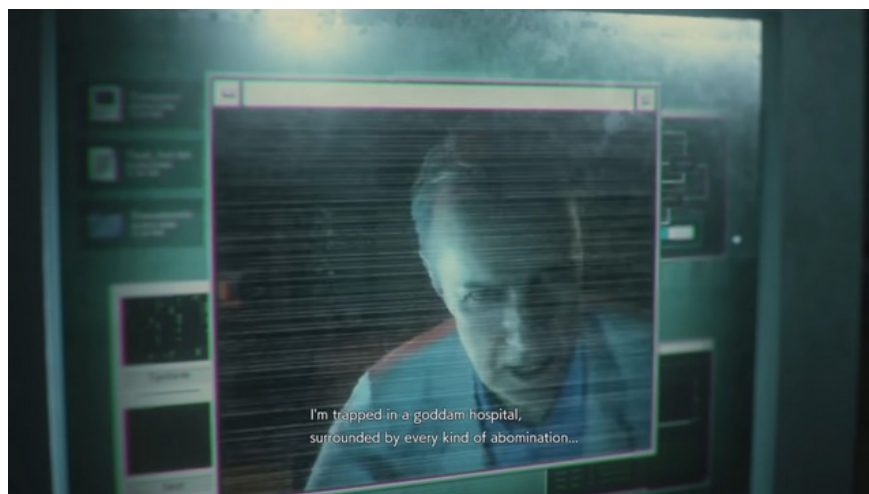


Resident Evil 3 Remake - Is Nemesis stronger or weaker than the original?

With a new shape and a bunch of new weapons, Resident Evil 3 Remake's Nemesis seems to be upgraded quite a lot compared to the original, so what about the power?

When the first signs of people infected with T-Virus appeared, Dr. Bard and many others were invited to a meeting to prepare an emergency isolation area. But a few days after the T-Virus flowed into the city's water system causing a pandemic outbreak, the Spencer Memorial Hospital was the first to be overwhelmed by the reception of thousands of people. Dr. Bard also received an order to find a way to make the Vaccine from Umbrella, so he took advantage of the existing patients to bring down NEST 2 for research.

After about a week of frantic work and producing a large amount of Vaccine stored in the basement, Bard gradually realized the situation was completely desperate, when Zombie flooded the city and the hospital was almost not still capable of cure. Bard also fears he will be blocked by Umbrella to keep the T-Virus secret, so he tried to contact people in the government to sell this secret to save himself, but unfortunately. unsuccessful.



When Carlos and his team were assigned the task of cloaking, he received a signal from Bard at the police headquarters, which inadvertently revealed his location. Bard was later killed by Nikolai, and at the last moment it seemed the doctor was regretting what he had done, so he left a video of everything that happened at Umbrella, as well as I hope someone brought this to the light.

And these are the important characters besides Jill that appear in the Resident Evil 3 Remake storyline, hopefully later in Capcom will clarify the missing details, as well as do not 'bring Carlos to market' as in the version. root again.
