List of popular Adobe Premiere shortcut keys

Note: On Windows is the Ctrl key, while on the Mac is the Cmd key.

Adobe Premiere shortcut controls Timeline

J: Play the video in the opposite direction (If you want Video Play to reverse faster, press the J key repeatedly).

K: Stop the video.

L: Play video (If you want Video Play faster, press the L key repeatedly)

? ?: 1 more frame.

Space: Play / Stop.

Enter: Render.

I: Mark mark points Print on a clip.

O: Mark a mark out on a clip.

+/-: Zoom in TimeLine / Zoom in TimeLine

Delete: Delete a source on the timeline.

Shortcuts for Adobe Premiere to select basic tools

V: Tool Selection.

A: tool Track Select Forward.

Shift + A: tool Track Select Backward.

B: Ripple Edit tool.

N: tool Roll Edit.

C: tool Razor.

Y: tool Slip.

U: Slide tool.

P: Pen tool.

H: tool Hand.

Z: Zoom In / Out.

S: Snap (Turn on / off).

X: Rate Stretch tool.

,>: tool Insert & Overwrite.

Shortcuts copy & paste on Adobe Premiere

Ctrl / Cmd + C: Copy.

Ctrl / Cmd + X: Cut.

Ctrl / Cmd + V: Paste.

Ctrl / Cmd + Shift + /: Duplicate.

Ctrl / Cmd + Z: Undo.

Ctrl / Cmd + Shift + Z: Redo.

Ctrl / Cmd + A: Select all.

Alt + Ctrl + V (Opt + Cmd + V for Mac) : Paste attributes.

Alt + X (Opt + X for Mac): Clear In & Out.

Keyboard shortcuts for Adobe Premiere to create new files

Ctrl / Cmd + Alt + N: Create a new kitchen.

Ctrl / Cmd + N: Create a new file.

Ctrl / Cmd + O: Open a new file.

Ctrl / Cmd + /: Bin new.

Ctrl / Cmd + I: Import the file.

Ctrl + Atl + I (Cmd + Opt + I for Mac): Browse for the file to import

Ctrl / Cmd + M: Export the file.

Ctrl / Cmd + Shift + S: Save As.

Ctrl / Cmd + W: Close Project.

Ctrl / Cmd + R: Speed ??/ Duration.

Ctrl / Cmd + T: New title.

Ctrl / Cmd + Shift + A: Uncheck all.

Above are the shortcut keys Premiere common, do not need to reiterate the importance of using shortcut keys in the editing will save you a lot of time like how to just 'click' children mouse right? Keep in mind some basic shortcuts on the Adobe Premiere keyboard to enhance your editing experience.
