

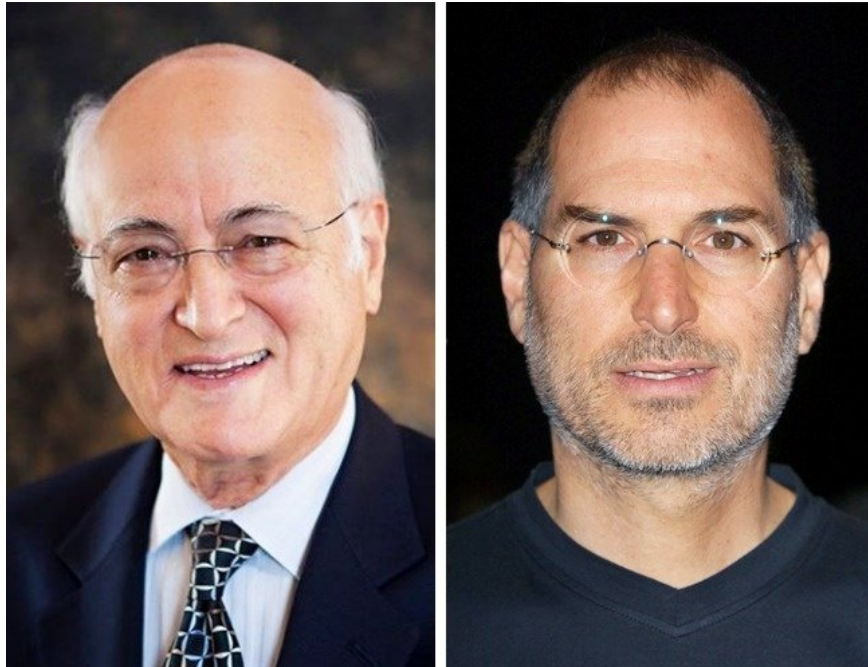
# Portraits of 6 major influential figures in the world were 'adopted children'.

## Steve Jobs and his biological father, Abdulfattah (John) Jandali



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**It was a father and a son who had been rejected since he was red .** In 1952, Jandali went to the United States to study for a Ph.D. in political science at the University of Wisconsin. His work underscores how to get Middle

Eastern countries out of colonial rule. While studying Ph.D., he fell in love with Joanne Schieble, Steve Jobs's biological mother, who had to give up the baby due to pressure from her parents. Joanne alone went to San Francisco, gave birth to Steve and immediately adopted the child.

**Steve Jobs was** born on February 24, 1955, at a private clinic in San Francisco. Steve was adopted by Paul and Clara Jobs. Joanne then lost sight of her son, when Jobs's house moved many times. **Paul Jobs, Steve's adoptive father, who imbued his child with electronic love** . Paul Jobs is also the payer of Steve Jobs's tuition, so he carries the blood of many countries. Steve Jobs himself does not like to call his parents "adoptive parents". Steve Jobs once affirmed: "*They are my parents 1,000% .*"

## **Nicole Richie and her biological father, Peter Michael Escovedo**



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**Nicole Richie** 's parents raised her to the age of three and then took her to the care of a friend named Lionel Richie. This is due to the difficult family financial situation: Nicole's parents simply cannot give her everything needed. Six years later, Lionel Richie and his wife, Brenda Harvey-Richie, officially accepted their daughter and Michael Jackson became her godfather.

In an interview, Nicole Richie confessed: "*My parents are friends with Lionel Richie . They believe I can be provided with better things .*" According to Nicole Richie, she still talks regularly with her mother.

## **Jamie Foxx**

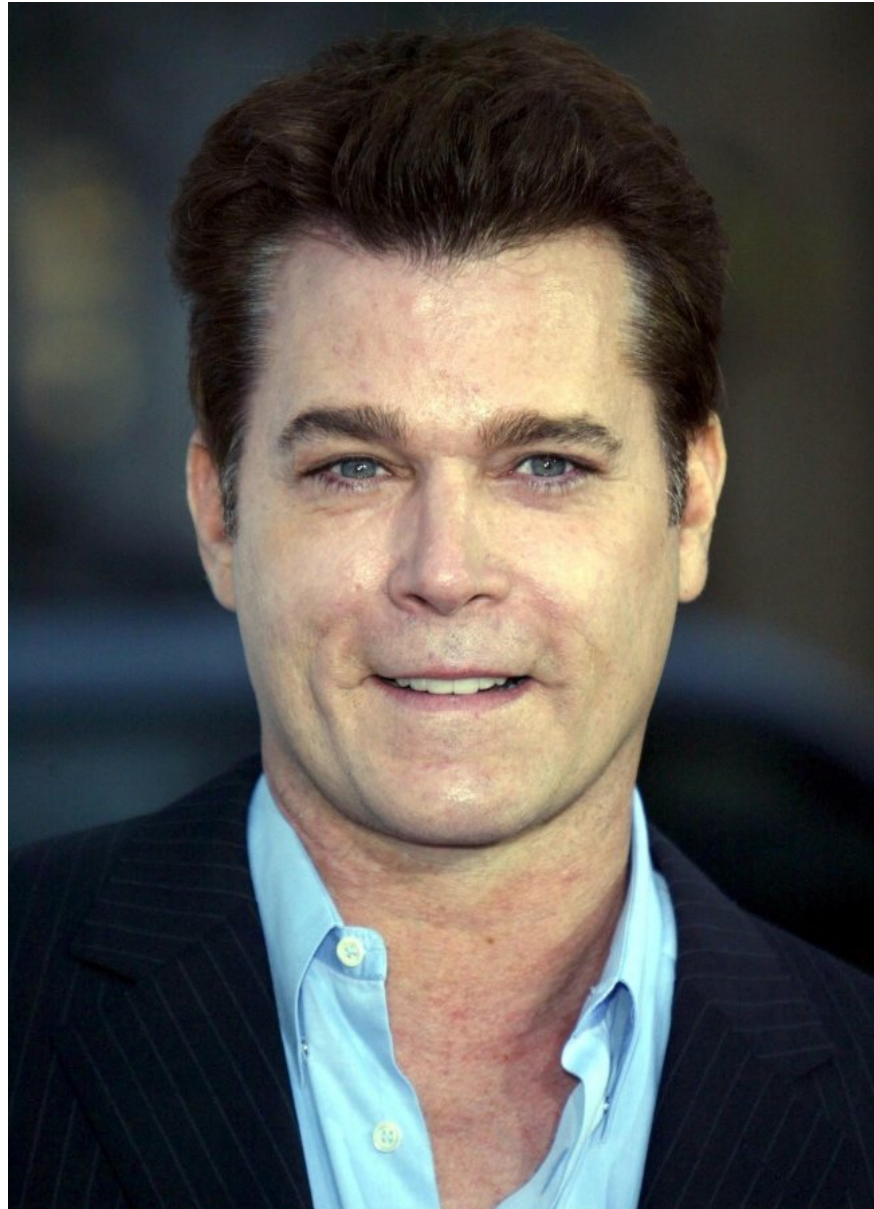

When **Coco Chanel** turned 12, her father left the family. She was sent to an orphanage, then to a Catholic monastery, and finally to a boarding school. According to Coco Chanel, it is this that motivates her to choose a career for the future: she is forced to wear the grayest uniform, the darkest color of her life, she dreams of all women in the world can wear. beautiful clothes.

## **John Lennon**



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Soon after **John Lennon** was born, his parents divorced. John Lennon's mother found a new man and the boy was given care to Aunt Mimi and her husband.
