How to trap and kill cockroaches with beer cans

We also know that cockroaches are "*superheroes*" in real life, they can live a month without eating even without their heads and still can live but they cannot live a week without water.

With only 1 can of beer you can destroy dozens of cockroaches in just one night. Put a **piece of bread on an old beer can with a beer** or use a beer can without drinking it all to stay where cockroaches often appear,

cockroaches will automatically go there and "die" here.



Because cockroaches like the water environment and especially like the aroma of beer. Proteins emanating from beer will stimulate cockroaches and signal them to be good prey. So the aroma of barley and water will be a must-see goal of cockroaches. And with the structure of the beer can make the cockroaches once entered, it is difficult to return.

Note:

In addition, you can also use **baking soda mixed with sugar in a 1: 1 ratio** and put in a tall bottle or jar to kill cockroaches. The sweet, aromatic taste of sugar is always attractive to cockroaches, while baking soda will create a reaction to the cockroaches of cockroaches, causing them to collapse on the spot.

You can put a little oil inside the mouth of the bottle to create a smooth surface so that the cockroach can easily fall off if it crawls into the bottle.



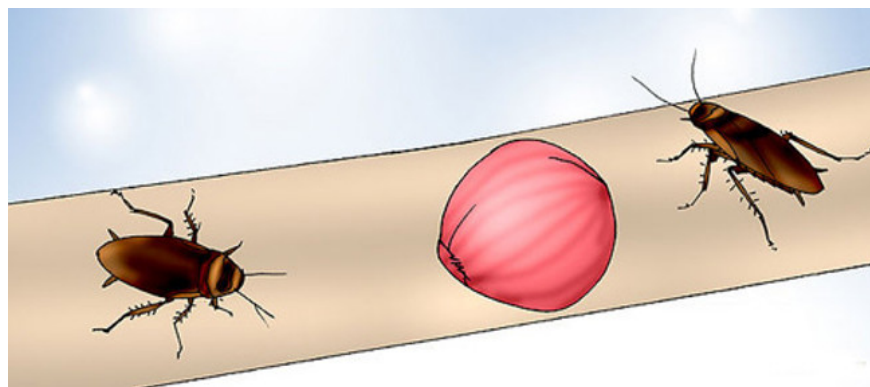
You can use wine bottles instead of beer cans to kill cockroaches

How to kill indoor cockroaches from sticky tape and onions

Onions have a very long odor and are so dark that they can be used to make good indoor cockroach traps.

Take a finely chopped onion in the center of the 20-30 cm long tape to attract cockroaches. Then place a piece of sticky tape on a poorly lit place, where cockroaches often appear.

Prepare a roll of the best adhesive tape to make sure the cockroach has put its foot on the tape, it will not be able to escape.



Note: If you do not use onions, you can use other foods to attract cockroaches like butter, peanuts, fragrant food and sweet taste.

What is baking soda?

Baking soda is the main ingredient of white sodium hydrocarbonate (NaHCO_3) or sodium bicarbonate with white color, easy to dissolve in water, good moisture absorption, this name is very common in chemistry and is widely used in the food industry. In Vietnamese baking soda known as "salt", "baking soda" (or mistaken for baking power), floating powder, sparkling medicine. In conventional communication its name is often called sodium bicarb, bicarb soda, or simply bicarb. In the food industry it is called the baking soda powder.
