

# PUBG Mobile: Tips to help you keep everything in your backpack

The following loot map tips will help you always get the full items for your backpack in PUBG Mobile

The worry of not enough baggage to "march" in PUBG Mobile VN is always a factor causing gamers to not get TOP 1 for themselves because of "poverty" and being bullied by "rich" people. So if there is a lack of many aspects, of course, the player will not have enough power to fight alone with surrounding enemies.

Even if you have comrades, most still depend on yourself, so the reasons why gamers are bullied when they lack items and weapons compared to those around them. Please refer to a few tips below to learn from experience.

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### 1. Skydiving in hot locations



In all four of PUBG Mobile's current maps, gamers must know all the hottest places and the most. And of course if you want to fill your backpack, you just need to jump down to those places to get your backpack full.

But with that, you will face fierce fighting, because any hot spot will have many players watching. Depending on how you jump, you will set your foot down fast or slow to loot the weapons and recovery items that prevail first.

## 2. Practice getting used to less user weapons



Specifically, weapons like Shotgun, Uzi, Vector, Thompson and some other weapons that few gamers touch. These weapons are abundantly everywhere on all 4 PUBG Mobile maps, and if your forte is one of these, then surely you don't have to worry about struggling "bon". If you are slower than others.

Another advantage is that the ammunition of these weapons is all "waste" in the eyes of many gamers, so you can loot comfortably without fear of missing. Especially with 9mm and .45 ACP bullets, if you like UMP and Vector, then surely there is no need to worry about ammunition, these two guns are both beneficial when used in the last round and more convenient. moreover, they take up very little space in your backpack.

## 3. Loot in small neighborhoods



If you can't jump in hot places, you can choose small neighborhoods for "walk" loot. Although not as many items as hot areas, there will still be enough demand for you and the level of fighting will be almost absent, and when loot in individual houses like this is likely high will also earn some transportation around.

At the Erangel, Miramar, the walking loot in these houses will be ineffective because very few small buildings are scattered on the map and these are the two most extensive maps, if you choose, you should choose loot on the edge of the hot areas on the map. On Sanhok there is a little better because there are many smaller buildings but they are still not scattered but only appear near the road.

Only Vikendi is perfect for this loot tip because there are so many buildings scattered around the map and not following any rules, just run for a while and you will see a small building and will have furniture Inside.

#### 4. Follow your teammates



Luckily, you will meet your teammates who have the heart and support you when you lack the items, especially those who are good at searching. What they have and if they have a spare, they will check for you to pick it up, and maybe you can catch something in the marked area. Meeting such comrades, you don't have to worry about missing things in your backpack.

## 5. Change the item to loot over time



At different times in the game, you have to change the items that need loot in your backpack. For example, at the beginning of a battle, weapons and ammunition are the top priorities when you parachute into hot areas and there are lots of fighting, certainly ammunition at this time you will need most when at the beginning of the battle.

But when in the middle until the end of the match, the new recovery item is something that you should put a lot in your backpack, now your ammunition can be reduced by 1/3 and put a place for First Aid Kit, Medication relieve pain, energy drinks . Simply because during this time, in addition to facing the enemy, you will be boiled by the blood but without "food and drink" the chances are high that you will "scary". So loot as many items as possible to recover, don't miss these "items" when you get to the end of the game.

## 6. Arrange backpack properly



If you don't know how to arrange your backpack, you will lack the necessary items even though your backpack is always full. Only loot the weapons you are most familiar with, don't loot things that aren't right for you, there

are many gamers who find it better than a gun holding a socks to grab, and then go and find accessories and bullets Put that weapon back from the beginning.

As for the recovery item, you should also arrange it to suit the needs and circumstances, First Aid Kit is fast, does not occupy much space, so it is more suitable than Med Kit if at the end of the game. As for the energy boosted item, it only needs to be around from the beginning to the end.

There are a few tips that will help you always have the necessary inventory in PUBG Mobile, refer to it, and if you have any defects, modify your backpack full of loot in the game.

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
