

Publisher Innersloth will update the system of fixed accounts for Among Us

After the **game Among Us** is updated, players are not required to create an account, but some of the features in Among Us will be locked. The system will focus on reporting and moderation, with security measures for all players, especially young children, said the developer.



Players will need to create an account to change their display name. Otherwise, the player will be in 'guest mode' and have to choose a random mode.

Child players under the applicable age (13 years in most countries) will require a parent or guardian's permission to access free chat, create an account, or change your display name. market.

The update will add reporting options like name, inappropriate chat, cheating, hacking, harassment, and misconduct. Innersloth may temporarily or permanently ban players who violate the code of conduct.

Later, **Innersloth** also plans to add a friend system, so that players can exchange items between platforms. In addition, Among Us is about to have an option to link multiple accounts (on Steam, Epic , mobile devices and Switch).
