My father once concluded: " *The words do not take money to buy, choose words to satisfy each other* ". Yet in fact, there are seemingly unintentional, short sentences that make listeners feel uncomfortable or even misunderstand your thoughts. It may be because the speaker shows indifference to you or your feelings.

In the following article, we will give specific examples to illustrate the statements that may lead to that " *disaster* ". You just need **to remember and avoid these 9 sentences to limit offending others !**

## "I told you" - "I know it right away!"



Life does not always happen like your will, doesn't it? People who have no mistakes at all. So, once it doesn't happen, do **n't blame or blame anyone** . You should not repeat this problem many times and show that you are right but they do not listen. That only makes others feel more uncomfortable. Let them realize that you're smart and know more than they do.

## "Yes" - "Okay"



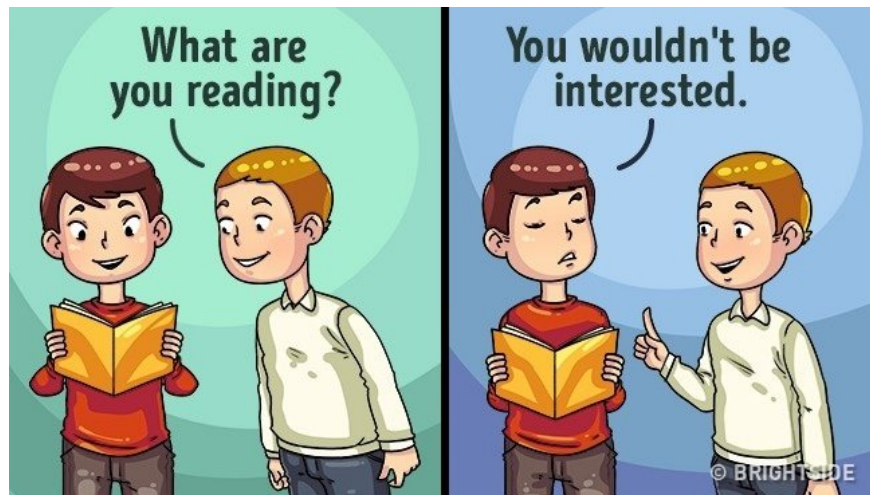
If you say a sentence in agreement while your face is still, it will definitely make others feel doubtful about its feasibility. Does your " Yes " mean " Yes, I will do it " or " Yes, I don't care ". So promised, you should do it right away, don't let others repeat it many times.

**"Sorry but truthfully ."**



Behind the words " *Sorry but honest* ." is definitely a bad idea. Why do you think that just apologizing for a sentence can say an ugly evaluation in the face of others? Do you know if people will feel offended?

## "You don't like it" - "You don't understand"



Imagine that what you like is probably something other people like. Saying something like " *You don't like it* " or " *You don't understand* " just makes others think you are thinking that they are ignorant, you despise them, but don't think you are interested and think for them. So pay attention to behave better!

## "Did you say anything to me" - 'You didn't tell me that'





The opponent is saying something to you and waiting for your feedback. But instead of facing those boring information, you just listen and don't do anything else. Saying " *I am listening* " or " *I understand* " while being engrossed in other things, not paying attention to the fact that the opponent is waiting for your opinion is a very **impolite thing** . All issues need to be discussed and cooperation from both sides can be solved.

### "Relax!"



A timeless comfort statement will definitely be counterproductive. Because doing so is no different from lowering the seriousness of the problem that the opponent is facing, instead of cheering or helping them to solve the problem, you can only assert that opponent's difficulties. only

### "There it goes again."



When the opponent is worried and needs a serious conversation to find a solution to the common problem of the two, never say the words " *Again and again* . ". Saying this statement is like you're **expressing a non-cooperative attitude** , even if you want to show the other person that you're extremely tired of the topic, please stop.

**"Why do you have to buy these things? It's very expensive. You're beautiful ."**





Are you really interested in the price issue? Or just because you feel bothered or don't want your other half to stand out? Sometimes **don't be too selfish but have to think for the opponent too** . If other people have conditions, let them reward themselves with good things a little bit so they don't always stop their interests.
