The query command displays information about Remote Desktop Session Host processes, sessions and servers (RD Session Host).

Syntax of the command

```
query process
query session
query termserver
query user
```

Displays information about processes running on the RD Session Host server.

query session

Displays information about sessions on the RD Session Host server.

query termserver

Displays a list of all the RD Session Host servers on the network.

query user

Displays user session information on the RD Session Host host.
