

Quick experience Find X2: efforts to advance to the high-end segment of OPPO

Very heavy opponent of Galaxy S20?

Find X is indeed a 'strange' product of OPPO, when it was launched on a forest of mid-range smartphones of the time, surpassing even other flagships of other manufacturers with the design. But it has to wait 2 years for us to have the successor to the **OPPO Find X2**, whether this continues to be a product that makes users 'look' as their predecessors?



The Find X2 version I have here is turquoise, with a bold color scheme as well as a very bright catch, so it makes a strong impression from the first try! The glass back means that the device will only be clean for the first few seconds when taken out of the box, then the user will have to clean it regularly if he does not want the device to become a 'fingerprint painting'!



OPPO logo is placed neatly on the left side of the back, looking at the diagonal corner we suddenly see more purple appears near the edge!



The camera cluster is placed vertically on the left side of the top instead of in a square similar to the current trend. With Find X2, we have a total of 3 cameras including the 48MP $f / 1.7$ main camera. 2x 13MP zoom camera and super wide 12MP $f / 2.2$ with angle of view equivalent to 16mm Full-frame lens.



Detailed reviews of this camera system will be sent to you in a review in the near future. But through a few snapshots, I appreciate the Find X2's ability to measure and white balance. It gives true color images with real life in difficult lighting / color conditions - a great advantage for both those who want to post photos and those who want to correct colors like me (with the correct 'background' for ease) easier post-production).

Compared to the Galaxy S20 Ultra, Find X2 lacks potential zoom because it only has a 2x camera. But such a comparison is not very fair because it also has a Find X2 Pro version that owns this feature. Find X2 will probably be a 'counterweight' to the Galaxy S20 Plus.

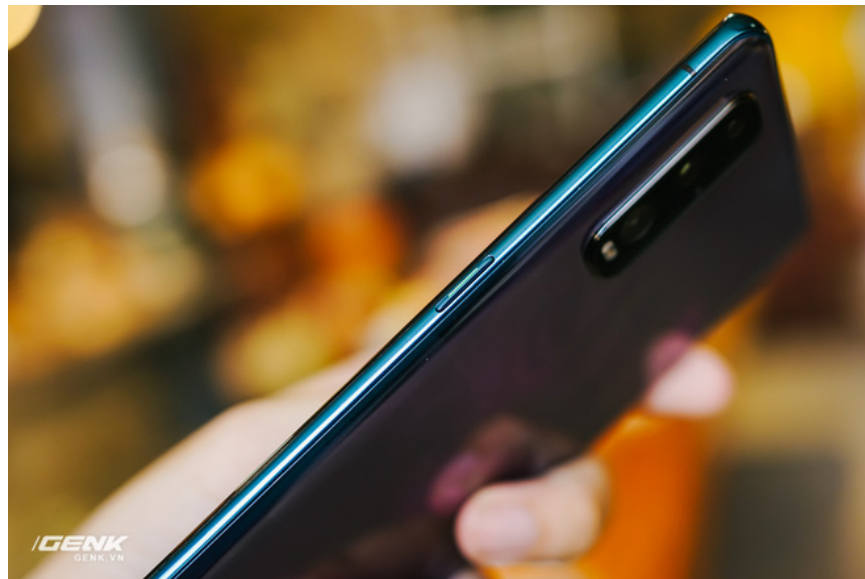




The device is quite thin in hand because both the back and the front screen are curved. If I use it for a long time, I will definitely use a case to prevent slipping and it will solve the fingerprint problem. The left side has two volume buttons .



. and on the right is the power button painted 'OPPO green'. All 3 buttons are placed low, so it's easy to operate, a big plus point in the design of this machine.



The bottom edge has a 2-SIM slot, speaker hole - combined with the speaker on the screen to create a dual speaker system and USB Type-C charging port.



Speaking of charging, this is a 'bright' factor, surpassing all other smartphones on the Find X2 market! Comes with the machine is a large charging dock like laptop charger, the wire is also unusually thick. The reason is that Find X2 is equipped with a Super VOOC 2.0 charging standard with a capacity of up to 65W!

To achieve this record number Find X2 owns 2 2100mAh batteries for 4200mAh capacity, can be charged simultaneously, in just 38 minutes can be full from exhausted state. In one attempt, I was able to charge the phone up to 40% in 10 minutes, 20 minutes to reach 73% and as advertised, the 37-38 minutes is full battery, really impressive!
