< Secure lock settings

Lock automatically

Lock the phone 5 seconds after the screen turns off automatically, except when kept unlocked by Smart Lock.

Lock instantly with Power key

If Smart Lock is in effect, the phone will stay unlocked.



Auto factory reset

After 15 incorrect attempts to unlock your phone, it will be reset to factory default settings, and all data will be erased, including files and downloaded apps.



Lock network and security

Network and security-related functions locked, and Wi-Fi and mobile data can't be turned off while your phone is locked, making your phone easier to locate and protect if it's lost or stolen



Show Lockdown option

Display a Power button option that turns off Smart Lock and notifications on the Lock screen.



When Lock network and security is on, others won't be able to disable tracking or connect. YourFind My Device, remote wipe, and other security features will still work, even if someone else picks up your phone.
