

Quick sharing of text with QuickNote

To quickly share online texts, we can use the QuickNote service without registering an account.

If you want to share online documents you will use Google Docs, viewers can edit and import content into the file. However, most of these services, including Google Docs, require account registration. In case users need to share documents online quickly without creating an account, QuickNote service can be used.

QuickNote supports editing content right on the web, sharing documents without having to register for an account. The following article will guide you how to use the QuickNote service to compose and share documents.

1. How to share files on Google Drive
2. How to create links to download files directly from Google Drive
3. How to set up the right to edit spreadsheets on Google Sheets

Instructions for using QuickNote to share documents

Step 1:

Users access the link below to open the QuickNote homepage.

1. <https://quicknote.io/>

Step 2:

In the main interface of the website you can **edit the content** with the editing tools provided. Enter the title of the content at the top Title bar.

The content below can be edited, copied and pasted. The links and images when copied to QuickNote remain the same. QuickNote editing tools are relatively rich, such as attaching files, inserting code, inserting links, creating lists, etc.

After finishing editing, click **the Publish button** above to export and save the text.

Finally, users click on **the Share button** to get the link and share it on Facebook, Twitter, via email, . Also we can copy the link of the text to send, click the Copy Link button.

The QuickNote service does not limit the amount of text created on the page.



A good service to share documents and documents without creating an account. You can enter document content regardless of length on QuickNote as well as the amount of text created. Sharing is also simple when the service creates text links to share.
