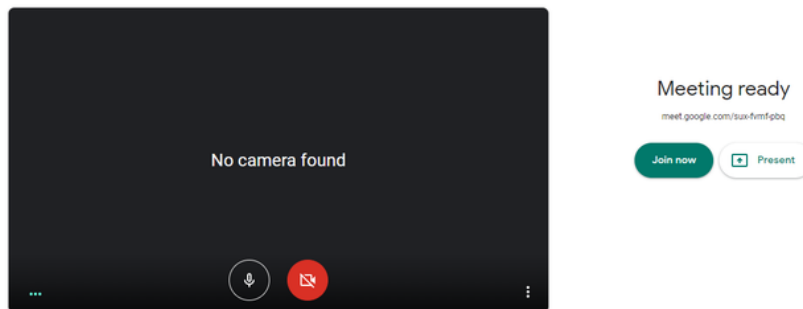


Quickly create a Google Meet meeting with a short domain name

In addition, Google makes it easier to create documents, spreadsheets, presentations, forms, and websites by providing many other '.new' domains. With these short domain names can easily help you create anything you need without having to go through the service home page and create new manual operations as before.

You can also add numbers to these shortcuts to help you distinguish between multiple accounts when making new meetings. For example, you create a 'meet.new/1' bookmark for personal calling purposes, and 'meet.new/2' for work-related calls. Google off domains now work in all browsers.
