

Quickly download the August 8 cumulative update of Windows 10 brothers

Earlier this month, Microsoft released Windows 10 build 15063.502 - cumulative updates containing all Windows 10 patches and updates since the Creators Update was released. Please read the following article for more details and install this cumulative update now!

New features have to wait until the Fall version in September, but now, this update fixes a large number of errors, including:

1. Solve the problem that the Microsoft Installer (MSI) application does not work with standard users (not admin) when installing on a per-user basis.
2. Solve the problem to support the configuration service provider DevDetail to return the UBR number in Part D of SwV.
3. Resolves an issue where NTFS spread files are unexpectedly cut (NTFS spread files are used by Data Deduplication - resulting in duplicate files that may be corrupted). The cumulative update also updates the **chkdsk** command line to detect corrupted files.
4. Fix the problem where IME Pad does not start correctly in Microsoft Edge browser for certain markets.
5. Solve problems to allow Win32 applications to work with Bluetooth LE devices.

6. Fixed an issue where device drivers could not load.
7. Solve the problem of reliability when broadcasting specific audio content in space.
8. Solve problems on Microsoft Surface keyboards and Microsoft Surface Ergo and troubleshoot Wacom drawing boards that are not connected to the stylus.
9. Troubleshooting to improve stability for USB-C while changing power supply.
10. Solve the problem of USB host controller not responding to attached peripheral devices.
11. Fix MP4 compatibility issues when playing content from the social media website in Microsoft Edge.
12. Solve problems with headphones connected to a PC via the Xbox 360 controller.
13. Solve reliability issues when launching the Settings app while another application is using the camera.
14. Solving the problem with SMS notifications, Calender tells the device to track the activity tracker.
15. Troubleshoot unresponsive Skype calls about 20 minutes after using a Bluetooth headset with the connection of Hands-Free Profile (HFP) and mSBC codec (Wideband Speech).
16. Solve the problem in which a service using Managed Service Account (MSA) cannot connect to the domain (domain name) after updating the password automatically
17. Troubleshooting that in some cases, the hard drive using hardware encryption on the drive does not automatically unlock when booting the system.
18. Fix the problem in which the **cipher.exe** / **u** security tool does not work on clients that are operated by InTune, Windows Information Protection (WIP) and updated DRA certificate (Data Recovery Agent).
19. Solve the problem in which users cannot add Work and School accounts in the Windows Store. Besides, you may get an error: '*We encountered an error; hãy hãy th? signing vào l?i sau.*'
20. Solve the problem in which if the Surface Hub goes into Sleep mode and then continue working, it may require users to log back into Skype.
21. Troubleshooting that some Windows Forms (WinForms) applications use DataGridView, Menu drivers in .NET 4.7. This is due to additional Garbage Collections. In some cases, the user interface (UI) is empty due to the lack of GDI + toolbar.
22. Solve the problem in which Magnifier Lens users cannot click the button or select web content in Microsoft Edge or Cortana search results.
23. Solve the problem introduced in the June updates, in which some applications cannot start when the device continues to operate from Connected Standby mode.

Microsoft said: There is no problem with this update, so you can go to Windows Update to download it now.

The KB4032188 update is available for PC and can be installed here, while the phone version is only available in the Release Preview Ring and will be released in the Production Ring next week.
