## Element for abbreviation

Element used to define acronyms or words created with the first letter of other words.

Indicate very useful acronyms for browsers, language translation software and search engines.

*for contact information*

Element

used to define contact information (owner / author) of text or article. This element is usually displayed in italics. Most browsers will break the line before and after this element.

### ***Element for the title of the work***

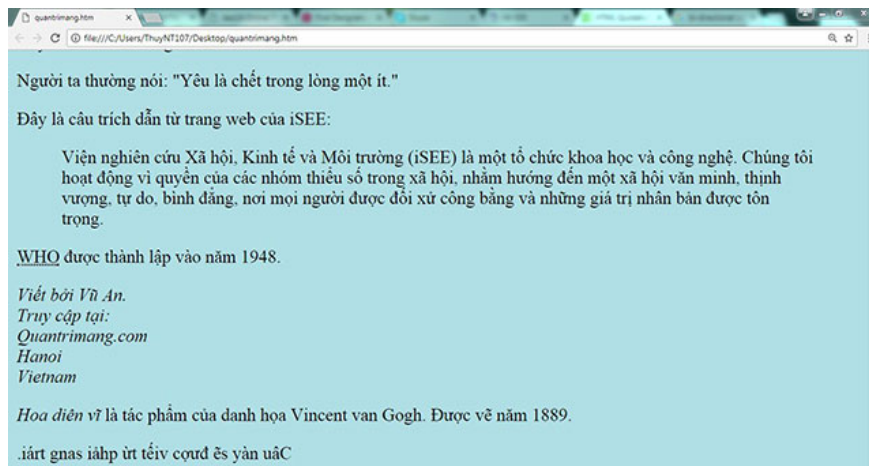
Element often used to define the title (name) of a work. Usually the browser will display this element in italics.

Element bi-directional override (bi-directional override) is used to define directional override, used to override the direction of the current text.

`dir = "rtl">` This sentence will be written from right to left.
