

Ranking champions from weak to strong Arena of Truth 9.17

With the rankings of champions in each stage in the Arena of Truth 9.17, even if you are a rookie, you will know which champion you should use in each phase of the game.

In the ranking of champions Arena of Truths 9.17, you need to know which hero is strongest to the weakest in each game stage to use the appropriate generals according to the lineup built in the stages of the match.

Below is the ranking of champions in the Arena of Truth 9.17 from strong to weak in each stage with 3 rank S> A> B divided into three stages which are Beginning, Mid-Battle and End-Battle.

There will be strong champions in the early game but will be weak in the later time of the game or vice versa. Helps you plan your squad in the first place and which champions to use in which time period.

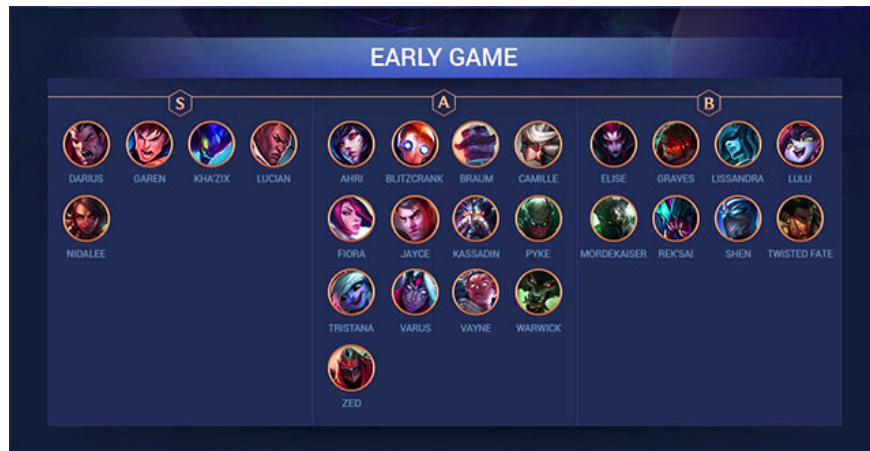
1. Want to climb quickly to the arena of Truth, skip these habits right away

Top strongest generals Arena of Truth 9.17

1. Early Battle

At the beginning of the match, you will have familiar names in the TOP rank including Darius, Garen, Kha'Zix, Lucian and Nidalee. Among these champions, Lucian has been nerfed, but can still be very early in the game if the stacking stack equips equipment like Electric Knife, Light Palace.

The two main tankers, Darius and Garen, are fine with their positions when they have the Knight buff. He helps teammates in the area of ??damage and still tank well until level 5-6 in the middle of the game.



Speaking of other strong and stable generals, Blitzcrank is almost a name that appears in every squad when having long-range skills that push his champion well. Ahri is also a name that is considered to be a good 2-star chess piece at the beginning of the match with her quite stable hand damage. In addition, wide area spells and Wild buffs are quite strong with Nidalee S rank.

2. Mid-Battle

In the middle of the game, familiar champions in the previous meta like Draven, Gnar and Akali and Kennen must be the top picks. Even if nerfed is not enough, Draven continues to hold the main carry position in every squad.

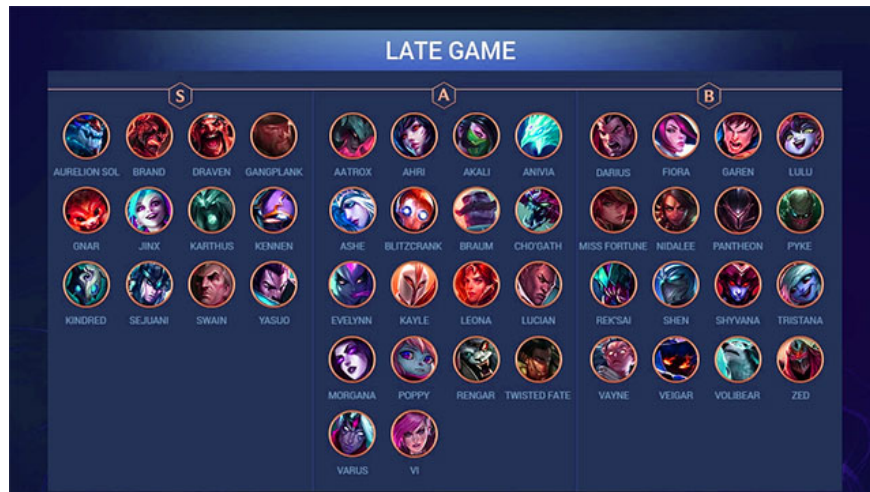
Meanwhile, Yordle has a new dodge rate buff that makes Gnar, Kennen, and Poppu stronger. Without skill nerf, even Lulu will benefit.



Other threats to worry about include Pyke, Rengar, Akali with stronger Assassin buffs than before and when combined with A rank champions, just as strong as the Gladiator. (Cho'Gath is still very strong despite being nerfed).

The Kingdom of Ice can also benefit from having an additional buff to the Archer, which can help Ashe and Kindred almost reach the S rank if not too dependent on the squad that they go with.

3. End of Battle



At the end of the game, the tanker generals will step back to give the top power to the main carry generals and can cause the highest damage in the team. Among them, some of the most worrying generals include.

1. Brand with new Devil buff along with the equipment stack
2. Draven will remain alone, pairing with the Empire, the Bow and the Cannons will become a real executioner.
3. Gangplank gets nerfed but his explosive stack is still too much compared to other 5 gold champions.

Other names like Jinx or Swain have been nerfed but with good and stable damage, they will still have "acting ground" in the late game. A few other A rank generals will have the "ability" to climb to dangerous S rank, including Ahri, Blitzcrank, Akali, Evelynn as the number of times they are used is increasing.

Based on the list and some of the suggestions in this article, you will know which personnel your team needs at what stage in the match. Even if you're a rookie, you still know which champions to use at what time in your battle.
